1. VEHICULAR ACCIDENTS IN LUCENA CITY, QUEZON

A. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- On or about 8:42 PM, 15 January 2013, a vehicular accident occurred in Diversion Road, Brgy. Gulang- Gulang, Lucena City. The head-on collision involved an Isuzu L200 pick-up type vehicle with plate number DPJ 991 driven by Romeo Afable Jimenez, 56 y.o. and a resident of Brgy. Cotta, Lucena City; and a motorcycle with plate number 9366WU driven by Felix Zacheus Reyes Perez, a 16 y.o. resident of Brgy. Gulang- Gulang, Lucena City and was said to be under the influence of alcohol
- As a result, both drivers sustained injuries and were brought to Quezon Medical Center for treatment

B. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

 At around 12:20 AM, 16 January 2013, a vehicular accident transpired in Brgy. Gulang- Gulang, Lucena City when the driver of a motorcycle heading towards the city proper of Lucena City suddenly lost control and consequently slipped. The following sustained injuries and were brought to Quezon Medical Center for treatment:

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- Quezon Emergency Rescue Team, PNP Quezon and BFP Lucena responded to both incidents
- OCD- RDRRMC IV-A coordinated with PDRRMO Quezon

2. MISSING PERSONS FROM MANSALAY, ORIENTAL MINDORO

SITUATION OVERVIEW:

 At around 3:00 PM of 14 January 2013 a motorized banca named "BATOY" with four persons onboard namely Kagawad Herbert Solidum, Gary Nunes, "Lapang" Finca and Danny Nunes, all residents of Brgy. Don Pedro, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro was reported missing, according to Mr. Noel Dacles, Executive Assistant of Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro. They were expected to arrive in Brgy. Don Pedro, Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro at about 8:00 PM of the same date but failed to do so

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- OCD IV-B coordinated with OCD Region VI, Coast Guard Southern Tagalog, Coast Guard District Palawan and Coast Guard Romblon for possible search and rescue operations
- Coast Guard Southern Tagalog, District Palawan and Romblon directed other nearby detachments to advise all ships/watercrafts and local populace transiting in the are to be on lookout and render necessary assistance
- Local Officials of Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro together with local populace are currently conducting localized search to the missing persons
- 3. INITIAL REPORT ON INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSONS DUE TO ARMED CONFLICT IN BRGY. NED, LAKE SEBU, SOUTH COTABATO

SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- On 5:45 AM of 12 January 2013 the CAFGU's were conducting their foot patrol
 operation in the intertior part of Brgy. Ned, Lake Sebu South Cotabato when
 they were fired upon by believed to be members of MILF breakaway group lead
 by unknown commander that prompted residents to leave their places for the
 fear of being crossfired in the encounter causing the death of 1 CAFGU
- Ninety- six (96) families/ 379 persons from Sitios Kumilat, Kisayan, and Blakul evacuated to Brgy. Ned Proper and stayed with their relatives

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- MDRRMC Lake Sebu conducted validation through coordination with PNP and AFP
- PDRRMC coordinated to OCD XII regarding the incident.

4. INITIAL REPORT OF FLASH FLOOD INCIDENT IN ISULAN, SULTAN KUDARAT

SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- On 15 January 2013, a flash flood incident occurred in Relocation Site, Purok Mabuhay, Brgy. Bambad, Isulan, Sultan Kudarat due to heavy downpour of rain which resulted to the overflowing of Allah River along Brgy. Bambad, Isulan, Sultan Kudarat
- There were forty (40) families affected of the said incident

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- BDRRMC Bambad and MDRRMC Isulan responded, secured the affected families and evacuated to Bambad Barangay Gym
- MDRRMC Isulan conducted DANA
- OCD XII continued monitoring and coordinated with the MDRRMO

5. BELATED REPORT re VEHICULAR ACCIDENT IN ANTIPOLO CITY

SITUATION OVERVIEW:

 On or about 12:55 PM, 15 January 2013, a vehicular accident occurred in Sumulong Hi-way, Brgy. Mambugan, Antipolo City involving the following vehicles:

- OCD-RDRRMC IV-A coordinated with CDRRMO Antipolo regarding the said incident

6. VEHICULAR FIRE INCIDENT IN QUEZON CITY

SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- On or about 8:15 PM of 16 January 2013 vehicular fire incident happened in Philcoa Commonwealth cor. Masaya St. Quezon City involving M.H. Transit airconditioned bus due to faulty electrical wiring
- No casualties reported and estimated damages is still under investigation

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- QC BFP, Traffic Sector and DPOS responded to the said incident
- OCD-NCR coordinated with Quezon City Fire District, Traffic Sector and DPOS
- QC fire investigators still processing their report

7. VEHICULAR ACCIDENT IN STAR TOLLWAY, MALVAR, BATANGAS

SITUATION OVERVIEW:

 On 16 January 2013, a vehicular accident occurred along Southern Tagalog Arterial Road (STAR) Tollway in Malvar, Batangas. A Mitsubishi vehicle slammed into the trailer truck that was trying to swerve towards the center island. Consequently, the truck broke down along the northbound lane of the highway's kilometer 70, causing the truck driver Angelito Cabadu to shift towards the center island. Upon collision, the Mitsubishi vehicle caught fire

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- STAR Tollway Response team responded to the incident and reported it to Malvar Municipal Police Station
- Malvar, Batangas MDRRMC, BFP and Municipal Police Station responded to the incident
- Mr. Angelito Cabadu, driver of truck is now detained at the Malvar Police Station
- The injured victims were brought to Damian Mercado Hospital for treatment
- OCD-RDRRMC IV-A coordinated with MDRRMO, BFP and PNP Malvar, Batangas regarding the incident

8. EFFECTS OF TAIL-END OF A COLD FRONT IN CARAGA REGION

SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- PDRRMC Dinagat Islands raised Alert Level 1 and advised the suspension of classes in preschool and elementary levels as recommended by PAGASA due to continuous rains in the past thirty- six (36) hours
- CDRRMC Butuan reported that as of 2:45 PM, 16 January 2013, water level in Agusan River was 2.70 meters above sea level and raised Alert Level 2
- At around 8:00 AM, 15 January 2013, Barangays Del Rosario and Cawilan, Tubod, Surigao del Norte were flooded
- Brgy. Sumo-sumo, Tago and San Miguel, Surigao del Sur were also flooded while only some parts of Brgy. Hinayhayan and Sitio Tagmalino, Cagwait, Surigao del Sur were flooded
- The floodings affected and displaced a total of <u>one-hundred forty- one (141)</u> <u>families/ seven- hundred (700) individuals</u> in <u>five (5)</u> evacuation centers/ <u>four (4)</u> barangays/ one (1) city/ one (1) municipality in Surigao del Norte

B. ACTIONS TAKEN:

- PDRRMC Surigao del Sur convened for an emergency meeting
- Search and Emergency Response Team of Surigao Sur (SERTSS) is on standby
- Clearing operations in Sitio Hinayhayan National road is still ongoing
- Conduct of rescue operation to flooded areas in Brgy. Cawilan, Tubod, Surigao del Norte is still ongoing
- On 15 January 2013, San Miguel, Surigao del Sur Government declared the suspension of classes in pre-school, elementary and high school. At around 2:00PM 16 January 2013, municipal government employees were advised to go home due to heavy rains
- CDRRMC Butuan assisted BDRRMC in conducting preemptive evacuation of the affected residents in P1, 3-A & 3-B of Brgy. Bading, Butuan City
- CDRRMC Surigao convened for an emergency meeting
- RDRRMC Operations Center continuously maintain 24/7 monitoring operation and disseminated 24-Hour Public Weather Forecast to the RDRRMC memberagencies, local DRRMCs and local radio/TV stations in the region
