## ACTIONS TAKEN:

### Regional Level

- OCD XI headed by Dir. Liza R. Mazo conducted survey of affected areas.
- OCD XI provided rescue equipments for augmentation in the conduct of rescue operations to affected areas.
- OCD XI continuously disseminating weather update and advisory.
- OCD XI is on red alert status

### Local Level

- PDRRMCs together with the MDRRMCs conducted Search & Rescue Operations and forced evacuation to the affected areas.
  - Davao CDRRMC together with 10th ID conducted Search & Rescue Operations and Forced evacuation to the affected areas.
  - PDRRMC Davao del Norte continuously monitoring Libuganon River and contributory rivers.
  - Kapalong Rescue and Emergency Services (KARES) on standby and ready for deployment.
  - Municipality of Sta. Cruz rescue group assisted Davao CDRRMC in the conduct of Search & Rescue Operations and evacuations to the affected areas.
  - CDRRMC IGACOS provided water assets for the ongoing Search and Rescue Operations and Forced Evacuation
  - Coast Guard SEM conducted Search and Rescue Operations and Forced Evacuation.
  - NFEM conducted Search and Rescue Operations and Forced Evacuation
  - Maritime Police conducted Search and Rescue Operations and Forced Evacuation.
  - CDRRMC Davao together with AFP, PNP, Central 911, Red Cross and Volunteers conducted Search and Rescue Operations.
  - PDRRMC Davao Oriental together with 67<sup>th</sup> IB and PNP conducted Search and Rescue Operations.
  - Philippine Navy terminated the conduct of Search & Rescue Operations and Evacuation at Brgy. Bankerohan, Davao City.
  - Davao Fire & Rescue Search Volunteer Group assisted Davao CDRRMC in the conduct Search & Rescue Operations of the affected areas.
  - P/M/C/DRRMC conducted distribution of assorted relief goods to the affected families.
  - Local Government of Davao City issued suspension of classes to all primary and secondary levels.
    - Municipality of Carmen, Davao Del Norte issued suspension of classes to all primary and secondary levels.
