1. Belated Report re Fire Incident in Pasig City

Situation Overview:

- On or about 8:18 PM, 19 June 2015, a fire broke out in Brixton St. Corner Perlin St. Brgy. Kapitolyo, Pasig City involving Absolute Sales Corporation-Warehouse.
- The fire reached 3rd Alarm at about 10:40 P.M and was declared fire out at 1:25 AM, 20 January 2015.
- · The cause of fire is still being determined

Effects:

The cost of damage is still being determined

Actions Taken:

- The following groups assisted in the fire fighting activities:
 - BFP-Pasig
 - Nearby BFP Stations
 - Fire Volunteers
- OCD NCR coordinated with Pasig Fire District regarding the incidents

2. Belated Report re Fire Incident in Boracay Island, Malay, Aklan

Situation Overview:

- On or about 2:50 PM, 17 June 2015, a fire broke out in Sitio Manggayad, Barangay Manoc-Manoc, Boracay Island, Malay, Aklan affecting residential houses and business establishments
- The fire was situated approximately 150 feet above the main road and the affected area was too congested with no fire hydrants and no access roads for fire fighters which contributed to the difficulty in suppressing the fire
- The fire was declared out at 7:10 AM, 18 June 2015
- The cause of fire is still being determined

Effects:

Approximately 230 families were affected

- · A certain Malou Namacpacan, 48 y/o, suffered first degree burn on both arms
- The cost of damage was estimated at PhP20,000,000.00

Actions Taken:

- The following groups assisted in the fire fighting activities:
 - Dolphin 1 mini fire truck
 - Dolphin 2 Anos fire truck with Boracay Island Special Fire Protection Unit (BISFPU) crew
 - PNP Boracay Tourist Assistance Center (BTAC)
 - Boracay Fire Rescue Ambulance Volunteer (BFRAV)
 - Shangri-la Fire Brigade
 - Boracay Island Water Company (BIWC) water tankers
 - Philippine Red Cross
 - Composite Fire Fighters of the Province of Aklan
- Convened MDRRMC Emergency Meeting on June 18, 2015 re effects and the assistance needed by the victims.
- Another meeting on June 19, 2015 was convened by the Incident Commander Hon. Jupiter Gallinero re relocation site and needed requirements for the fire victims
- LGU Malay to conduct special session to decide whether to declare the Municipality under the state of calamity.
- MDRRMC Malay, through MSWDO, provided relief assistance to the fire victims
- Municipal Health Office provided medicines.
- BDRRMC, Brgy. Manoc-Manoc facilitated the transfer of victims to the relocation site.
- Resort owners donated relief items.
- OCD VI coordinated with BFP, BISFPU, and MDRRMC Malay re the incident and continuously monitors the situation for updates.
- OCD VI provided technical assistance to LGU Malay during the conduct of Emergency Meeting.
