The Low Pressure Area (LPA), 460 km East of General Santos City (4.5°N, 129.0°E) will bring cloudy skies with moderate to heavy rains and thunderstorms over Mindanao, Leyte provinces, Negros provinces and Bohol.

Heavy Rainfall Yellow Advisory is issued in Southern Leyte; Leyte (Matalom, Bato, Hilongos, Hindang, Inopacan); Bohol.

Flooding is possible in low-lying areas and landslides in mountainous areas.

The public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management council concerned are advised to monitor the weather condition and watch out for the next advisory to be issued in the next 3 hours or whenever significant changes occur.
