Moderate to heavy rainfall was observed over Metro Manila, Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon, Bulacan, Pampanga, Bataan and Zambales, and most likely to continue for the next 3 hours.

Light to moderate rains over Nueva Ecija and Tarlac.

Flooding is possible in low-lying areas and those located near the river channels.

Local DRRMC's are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

People are advised to closely monitor the weather condition and watch out for the next update to be issued in the next 3 hours or whenever significant changes occur.
