Moderate to heavy rainfall was observed over Rizal, Quezon, Bulacan, Pampanga, Bataan, Zambales and some areas of Metro Manila (Quezon City, CAMANAVA, Manila, Pasig, San Juan, Mandaluyong and Makati), and most likely to continue for the next 3 hours.

Light to moderate rains over Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Nueva Ecija and Tarlac.

Flooding is possible in low-lying areas and those located near the river channels.

Local DRRMC's are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

People are advised to closely monitor the weather condition and watch out for the next update to be issued in the next 3 hours or whenever significant changes occur.
