 BELATED REPORT ON CAPSIZED VESSEL "M/V ANGELICA GRACE" IN CABAHUG WHARF, MANDAUE CITY

SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- On or about 09:46 AM of March 11 2013, "M/V Angelica Grace", a RORO type vessel owned by Rapal Shipping Lines capsized while moored and loading cargoes at Cabahug Wharf, Mandaue City.
- · No casualties reported.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) Station-Cebu assessed the situation and confined oil spillage.
- Mandaue City Government monitored the area and consulted the PCG and DENR to check on the damage since there are fishing grounds nearby.
- In coordination with the City Government and PCG, Rapal Shipping Lines drafted a plan for salvaging of the ship.
- 2. INITIAL REPORT ON DROWNING INCIDENT IN PAMPLONA, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL

SITUATION OVERVIEW:

 On or about 3:00 AM of March 10, 2013, drowning incident happened in Barangay Abante, Municipality of Pamplona, Negros Oriental, due to continuous heavy rains. One casualty was reported as EMELYN BENTOLERO BOQUECOSA, 14 years old, female.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- MDRRMC Pamplona and BDRRMC Abante retrieved the body along the stretch of the creek.
- Burial assistance was provided to the family by the C, MDRRMC-Pamplona.
