1. Drowning Incident in Apalit, Pampanga

- On or about 3:00 PM, 10 April 2013, two (2) individuals, Lolita Mandap Bernardino, 13 y/o, and Khaela Rufino Gonzalez, 12 y/o, went swimming with friends and drowned in the Pampanga river in Barangay Sulipan, Apalit, Pampanga.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- DRRMO Pampanga WASAR Team, PNP-RPSB , PNP Apalit, and SBMA WASAR Team** conducted SAR and retrieval operation and recovered the bodies of the victims at 12:05 PM and 8:15 AM, 11 April 2013, respectively.

2. Fire Incident in Bacolod City

- On or about 4:30 PM, 8 April 2013, a fire broke out at Purok Sigay, Barangay 2, Bacolod City.
- Ten (10) houses were totally damaged while three (3) were partially damaged.
- A total of 13 families/ 65 persons were affected and evacuated at the Barangay Hall and at the house of the Barangay Chairwoman.
- The estimated cost of damage was pegged at PhP500,000.00.
- No casualties were reported.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- Fire Station Bacolod City, Chamber Volunteer Fire Brigade, Amity Volunteer Fire Brigade, and Bacolod Rescue** responded to the incident.

- **Women Community Volunteers of Barangay 2** organized the orderly evacuation procedure of victims and assisted the City Social Workers in the validation of affected families and community kitchen undertaking.
 - **Philippine Red Cross Negros Occidental, Bacolod City Chapter and the City Government of Bacolod** provided food packs to the affected families.
 - **Various Private Sectors/ Individuals** donated food items to the victims.
