1. Initial Report re Vehicular Accident in Tibiao, Antique

- On or about 5:30 AM, 12 April 2013, a vehicular accident occurred at Sitio Calaugan Bridge, Tibiao, Antique involving a Ceres Bus Liner RORO with plate number UVN – 727 from Manila bound to Iloilo City with forty six passengers on board.
- Initial investigation revealed that the driver named Mr. Romel Gipa Bandola, 39 years old and a resident of Brgy. Saimsun, Calamba, Laguna lost control while maneuvering the sharp curve along the Calaunan Bridge and fell down five meters deep.
- One (1) passenger named Mariano Gersaniva Geriane, 60 years old, reportedly died, two (2) were seriously injured and thirty five (35) others suffered from minor injuries due to the accident.
- Injured passengers were brought to Barbaza District Hospital, Barbaza and RHU Tibiao for medical treatment.

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- Trained volunteers of MDRRMC Tibiao along with the Tibiao Emergency Response Team and Red Cross Safety Service Volunteers responded to the incident.
- The Management of the Ceres Liner assisted in providing medical treatment to the injured passengers and hired local private contractors for the retrieval of the bus.
- MDRRMC Tibiao headed by MHO Dr. Rue Joanna F. Española set-up Mass Casualty Command Post near the site by providing medical treatment to the victims who suffered minor injuries while Mr. Richie G. Jeremia of MDRRMO headed the Rescue and Retrieval Operation. PI Winnie P. Andico was in charge of the Crowd Control.

- Tibiao Police secured luggage of the passengers by safekeeping the retrieve items at their station.
- OCD VI monitored the situation.
