1. FIRE INCIDENT IN MANDALUYONG CITY

SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- On or about 01:59 PM, 04 May 2013, a fire incident occurred at Mabini St., Shaw Blvd., Mandaluyong City which reached the 2nd Alarm before it was declared fire out at 03:05 PM.
- The incident involved more or less 10 residential units and affected 10 families
- Estimated amount of damages is more or less Php 2,000,000.00
- The cause of fire is still under investigation

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- Mandaluyong BFP, other Fire Brigade Volunteers and Philippine Red Cross responded to the scene.
- OCD NCR coordinated with Mandaluyong FSTN for information and status of the victims

2. TORNADO INCIDENT IN PANIQUI, TARALAC

 On or about 03:00 PM, 03 May 2013, a tornado incident occurred in Paniqui, Tarlac affecting four (4) barangays.
