1. PROGRESS REPORT RE LANDSLIDE INCIDENT IN KABASALAN, ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY

Situation Overview:

- On or about 2:30 PM, 28 May 2013, a landslide occurred in Brgy. Sayao, Kabasalan, Zamboanga Sibugay due to heavy rainfall brought by Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) and buried an abandoned house where four (4) children were resting inside while waiting for the rain to stop
- As of the reporting time, only one body was recovered by search and retrieval operations:

Actions Taken:

- On 31 May 2013, Mayor George Chiong Cainglet convened the Kabasalan LDRRM Council Members re Search and Retrieval Operations for the victims of the landslide.
- Kabasalan-MPS, MSWDO, Barangay Officials, Tanods Red Cross and LGUs of Kabasalan, Zamboanga Sibugay conducted recovery and retrieval operations.
- OCD IX coordinated with PDRRMC Zamboanga Sibugay and Kabasalan LDRRMC and continuously monitoring for any development of the incident

2. TORNADO IN SAN PABLO, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR

Situation Overview:

- On or about 5:30 PM 26 May 2013, a tornado (buhawi) incident occurred in Brgy. Marcos Village, Port Area, San Pablo, Zamboanga del Sur
- One (1) fishing boat was totally destroyed and a total of twenty-eight (28) houses were damaged: thirteen (13) were totally destroyed and fifteen (15) were partially damaged
- A total of twenty-eight (28) families are affected. Fifteen (15) families are staying with their relatives and neighbours and thirteen (13) are in the evacuation centers (Brgy. Hall and schools)
- There are no casualties reported

Actions Taken:

- San Pablo-LGU provided rice and monetary assistance
 - PRC ZDS-Pagadian City Chapter distributed rice, noodles and sardines to affected families
 - OCD IX is continuously monitoring the situation
