

1. INITIAL REPORT RE VEHICULAR ACCIDENT IN SAN PABLO CITY, LAGUNA

Situation Overview:

- A vehicular accident occurred along Maharlika Highway in Barangay San Vicente, San Pablo City, Laguna on or about 7:20 AM, 5 June 2013. The accident involved two buses carrying five passengers each: P & O Transport Bus which was driven by Mr. Dennis Amante, and Raymond Transport Bus which was driven by Mr. Mike Oporto.
- Based on the initial investigation, Raymond Bus was traversing towards Manila when it suddenly lost its brake and headed towards the opposite lane. It then hit P & O Transport Bus.

Effects:

- The accident injured all passengers and drivers of both buses. As of reporting time, only two of the ten passengers were identified namely: Mary Ann Lichaca, 16 y.o. and Jesiel Ann Lichaca, 20 y.o.
- Mr. Mike Oporto is currently detained at San Pablo Police Station

Action Taken:

- OCD- RDRRMC IV- A coordinated with CDRRMO San Pablo City and PNP

2. INITIAL REPORT RE FIRE INCIDENT IN BACOR CITY, CAVITE

Situation Overview:

- A fire incident occurred in Barangay Talaba 6, Bacoor City Cavite at around 5:51 PM, 5 June 2013. At around 6:29 PM, the fire was already under control.

Effects:

- The number of families affected is still undetermined but the incident damaged more or less thirty (30) houses
- No casualty was reported as of reporting time

Action Taken:

- OCD- RDRRMC IV- A coordinated with CDRRMO Bacoar and BFP Bacoar

3. LIGHTNING INCIDENT IN NATIVIDAD, PANGASINAN**Situation Overview:**

- A lightning incident killed a man in Barangay Barangobong, Natividad, Pangasinan at around 3:00 PM, 4 June 2013.
- Investigation disclosed that the victim was in a rice field during a heavy downpour when the lightning hit and killed him instantly.

Effects:

- DEAD: Roldan Gatchalian, 19 y.o., Male

Action Taken:

- OCDRC 1 is continuously monitoring its AOR

4. INITIAL REPORT RE FLOODING IN DAVAO REGION**Situation Overview:**

- Flooding incident occurred in parts of Davao Region on or about 8:00 PM, 5 June 2013 due to heavy rains caused by Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ). The incident caused heavy traffic in Davao City and some roads were not passable. Water level in the said areas subsided gradually.
- Also, water level in Matina- Balusong and Talomo River increased

Effects:

- Preemptive evacuation was conducted in Barangays Matina and Talomo. Unidentified number of families were forced to stay at Barangay Halls of Matina and Talomo

Actions Taken:

- BDRRMCs Matina and Talomo, and CDRRMC Davao conducted preemptive evacuation
- OCD XI is continuously monitoring the situation
