SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- On or about 5:45 AM, 14 June 2013, a marine vessel marked M/V Lady of Carmel operated by Medallion Shipping Lines based in Cebu City capsized at the vicinity of Claveria, Burias Island, Masbate
- A total of sixty-four (64) were aboard the said vessel of which more or less thirty-five (35) are manifested passengers, twenty-three (23) are crew members, with two (2) buses, and one (1) six-wheeler truck

ACTIONS TAKEN:

- RD, OCD5 together with 903rd Brigade Commander, TOG5 Commander and NAVFORSOL Rep proceeded to Aroroy, Masbate onboard PAF aircraft
 - Coordinated with PCG District Commander, PDRRMO and LGU officials
 - Met families/relatives of missing victims
- Search and Rescue efforts are being conducted by CGS Aroroy and Pioduran, Masbate PPO, MDRRMC, Bantay Dagat and local fishermen
- NAVFORSOL assisted in the SAR operations
- DOH-CHD5 alerted PHO Masbate
- Coordinated with PDRRMO Masbate, CGDBCL, CGS Pioduran
- OCD-RDRRMC OPCEN is on Alert Status and continuously monitoring the situation

ASSETS DEPLOYED

- One (1) big rescue motorized banca from LGU Claveria
 - Motorized fishing Banca from LGU Aroroy
 - PCG deployed MCS 3006 (BFAR Vessel) and utilized MV Rosary (Sister ship of MV Carmel) for SAR.
 - One (1) Volco helicopter from PCG en-route to incident area ETA 141030H June 2013
 - DF 321 and PG 374 underway to incident area together with one (1) NAVSOU team equipped with diving gears and rubber boats
 - At 1201H UH1H 507, from 505th Search and rescue group (SARG) and UH1H 494 with one (1) team para jumper en-route to TOG5 for deployment to incident area
 - Dispatched one (1) SARG Heli and one (1) Huey for SAR on or about 3:30 PM
 - PNP personnel based in Pioduran provided security and assistance to the survivors and other administrative requirements
 - Aroroy Municipal Clinic provided medical services to the survivors. On-going medical monitoring and alert
 - One (1) Philippine Navy Islander (PN311) conducted aerial recon at vicinity Punta Aguja, Burias Island, Masbate
 - Completed mission on or about 2:00 PM
