1. FLOODING INCIDENT IN BROOKES POINT, PALAWAN

Situation Overview:

- As of 6:00 AM, 21 June 2013, ninety seven (97) families / three hundred seventy seven (377) persons were affected by flooding and temporarily sheltered in Brookes Point Sports Complex and Convention Center.
- Although flood waters are now subsiding, classes in all levels are still suspended.

2. TORNADO INCIDENTS IN OCCIDENTAL MINDORO AND PALAWAN

Situation Overview:

- Two (2) tornado occurrences were reported on 20 June 2013 in MIMAROPA
- At about 7:30 AM, a tornado hit Brookes Point Palawan that caused damages to Extramural Studies Center of Palawan State University in Brgy. Pangobilian
- Six hours later, another tornado occurred at Brgy. Burol, Looc, Occidental Mindoro that damaged two (2) residential houses
- There are no reported casualties on both incident

3. RESCUED FISHERMEN IN CORON, PALAWAN

Situation Overview:

- At about 2:00 PM, 20 June 2013, a motorized banca with markings "Jennywin" with three (3) fishermen onboard reportedly capsized between the vicinity of Brgy. Tara and Sitio Bayang, Brgy. Turda Coron, Palawan
- All the fishermen have been safely rescued in good physical condition by the Coast Guard Detachment Coron.

4. RESCUED PASSENGERS OF MBCA "SALVE"

Situation Overview:

- On or about 6:30 PM, 20 June 2013, a motorized banca with marking "Salve" departed Brgy. Poblacion, Dumaran, Palawan bound for Brgy. Sta. Teresita, Dumaran, Palawan with eighteen (18) passengers onboard and one (1) boat operator
- The boat reportedly capsized in the vicinity of Dumaran Channel due to strong winds and rough seas
- The 18 passengers and one boat operator have been safely rescued and brought to Brgy. Sta Teresita.

Actions Taken:

OCDRC IV-B

- Disseminated Weather Bulletins, Flood Advisories and Gale Warnings to PDRRMCs, CDRRMCs, LGUs and line member agencies through SMS and facsimile and uploaded the same to OCD-RDRRMC IV-B Facebook and Skype accounts to ensure widest dissemination of these advisories.
- Placed Operations Center on alert status for monitoring/coordination/assistance
- Advised all LGUs to put their operations center on Alert Status for monitoring/coordination/assistance.
- Coordinated with PCG Palawan and MDRRMO Dumaran Palawan re: status of capsized MBCA "Salve" in Dumaran Palawan and capsized motorsized banca in Coron Palawan.
- Continuous coordination with response agency and monitoring of weather situation in area of responsibility

DSWD IV-B

- Alerted all social welfare and development team staff and quick response team in their respective provinces
- Prepositioned available stockpile in provincial warehouses for possible augmentation

DPWH IV-B

- Prepositioned heavy equipment in strategic areas for possible clearing operations
- District Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Teams on standby alert and advised to monitor their area of responsibility

CHD-HEMS IV-B

- Coordinated with all CHD Extension Office Provincial Health Team Office and City Health Team Offices
- Prepositioned assorted drug and medicines in five provinces of MIMAROPA

KABALIKAT CIVICOM MARINDUQUE

- All members are on 24 hrs standby mode
- Broadcast weather updates every 12 hrs thru radio and SMS

COAST GUARD DISTRICT PALAWAN AND SOUTHERN TAGALOG

- Disseminated weather bulletin and gale warning to their respective stations and detachments
- Assisted in the rescue operations in Brgy, Pangobilian, Brookes Point, Palawan

MDRRMC BROOKES POINT, PALAWAN

- · Activated their Operations Center.
- Conducted ocular inspection in low-lying areas for possible evacuation
- Conducted rescue operations to the affected families in Brgy, Pangobilian, Brookes Point, Palawan.
- MSWDO Brookes Point set up community kitchen and provided food to the evacuees

MDRRMC MAGSAYSAY, PALAWAN

- Convened in preparation for Tropical Depression Fabian
- Conducted ocular inspection in hazard area

MDRRMCs BUSUANGA, CUYO AND BATARAZA, ALL IN PALAWAN

Activated their Operations Center and alerted all responders for possible deployment.
