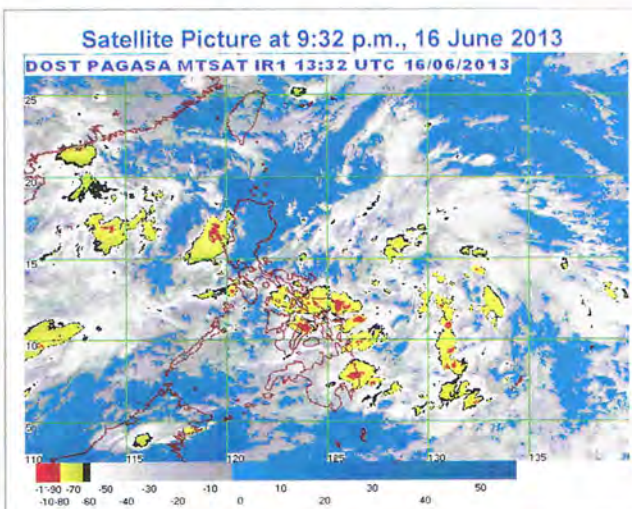
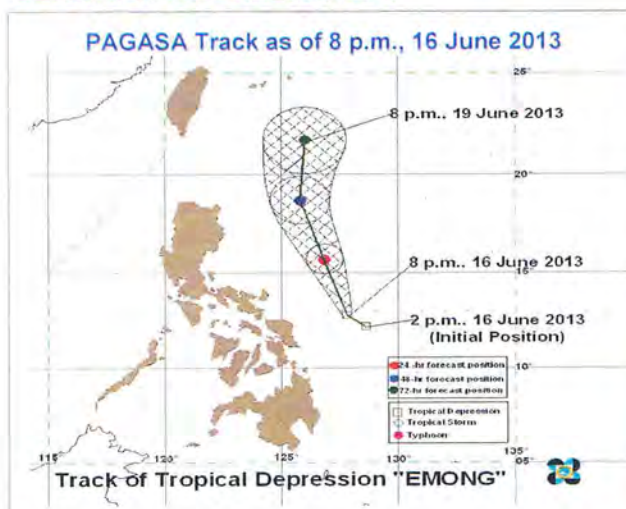

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TROPICAL DEPRESSION "EMONG" HAS MAINTAINED ITS STRENGTH AS IT SLIGHTLY ACCELERATED.



Location of Center: (as of 10:00 PM)	380 km East of Legazpi City
Coordinates:	13.2°N, 127.6°E
Strength:	Maximum winds of 45 kph near the center
Movement:	North Northwest at 13 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	Monday evening: 360 km Northeast of Legazpi City Tuesday evening: 400 km East of Aparri, Cagayan Wednesday evening: 530 km Northeast of Aparri, Cagayan

- Estimated rainfall amount is from 5-15 mm per hour (moderate - heavy) within the 300 km diameter of the Tropical Depression.
- Tropical Depression "EMONG" is still far to directly affect any part of the country. However, it will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.
- "EMONG" is likely to intensify within the next 24 to 48 hours.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- NDRRMC Operations Center disseminated Weather Bulletin No. 02 on Tropical Depression "EMONG" to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
 - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their area of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
