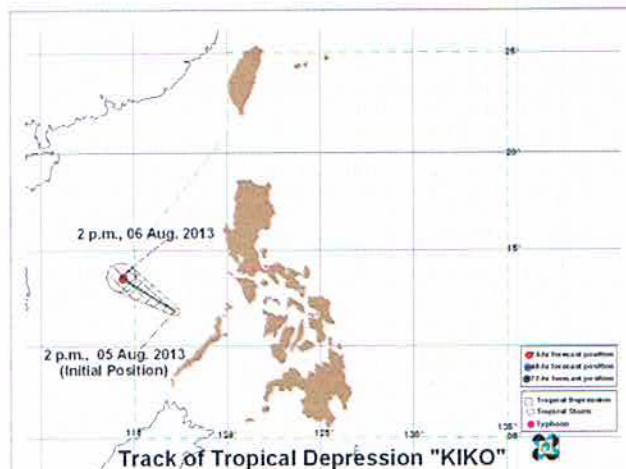

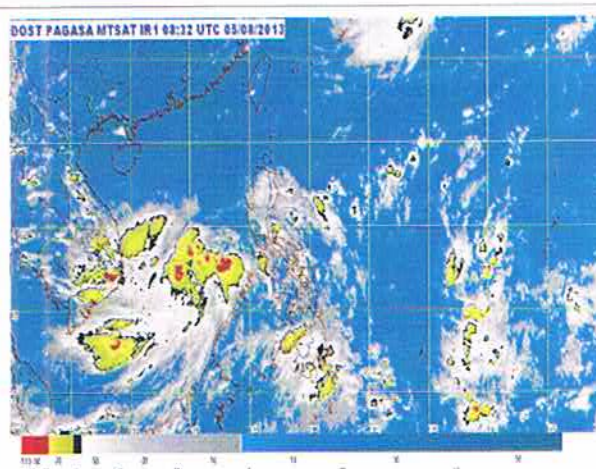

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The Low Pressure Area (LPA) North of Puerto Princesa City has developed into a Tropical Depression and was named "KIKO".

Location of Center: (as of 4:00 pm)	280 km Northwest of Puerto Princesa City or 320 km West of Coron, Palawan
Coordinates:	(11.9°N, 117.0°E)
Strength:	Maximum winds of 55 kph near the center
Movement:	West Northwest at 15 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	Tuesday afternoon: 680 km West of Calapan, Oriental Mindoro or outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR)
NO PUBLIC STORM WARNING SIGNAL RAISED	

- Estimated rainfall amount is from 5 - 15 mm per hour (moderate - heavy) within the 300 km diameter of the Tropical Depression.
- The public and the disaster coordinating councils concerned are advised to take appropriate actions

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- NDRRMC Operations Center disseminated Weather Bulletin No. 1 on Tropical Depression "KIKO" to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
 - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their area of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants
