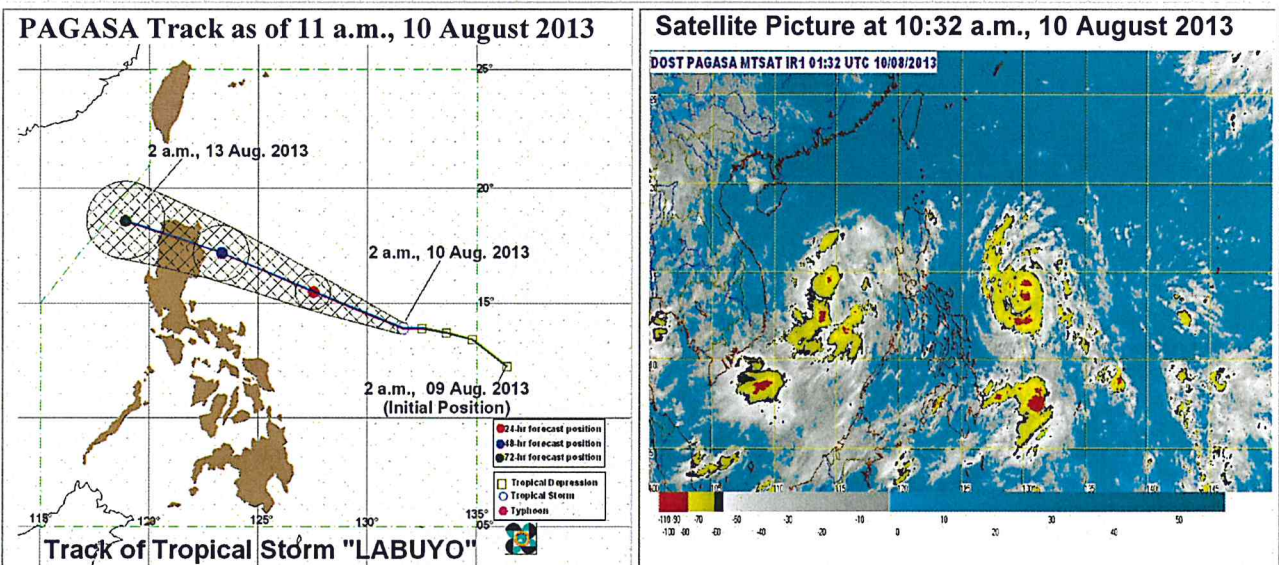

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Tropical Storm "LABUYO" has intensified as it continues to move west northwest in the general direction of Northern Luzon.



Location of Center: (as of 10:00 am)	570 km East of Virac, Catanduanes
Coordinates:	(13.8°N, 130.1°E)
Strength:	Maximum winds of 85 kph near the center and gustiness of 100 kph
Movement:	West Northwest at 19 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	<p><i>Sunday morning:</i> 240 km Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes</p> <p><i>Monday morning:</i> in the vicinity of Cauayan City, Isabela</p> <p><i>Tuesday morning:</i> 240km Northwest of Sinait, Ilocos Norte or in the Northwest boundary of PAR</p>

- **Estimated rainfall amount is from 5 - 16 mm per hour (moderate - intense) within the 400 km diameter of the Tropical Storm.**
- **The public and the local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.**

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) are advised to take appropriate actions.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- **NDRRMC Operations Center disseminated Weather Bulletin No. 4 on Tropical Storm "LABUYO" to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels**
- **Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants**
