### **I. Initial Report re Capsized Motorized Banca in Region VII**

#### **A. Situation Overview:**

- On or about 1:30 PM, 02 July 2015, a fishing vessel "Inday Sweet" departed from Masbate bound for Cadiz, Negros Occidental with seven (7) fishermen aboard reportedly capsized between Gigantes Island, Panay, Negros Oriental and Madridejos, Cebu
- The status of the fishermen are still undetermined
- The name of the fishermen are as follows:
  - 3.1 Johnrey Vergara
  - 3.2 Antic Celeste
  - 3.3 Gerry Bangalisan
  - 3.4 Norberto Patriarca
  - 3.5 Certain Jomar
  - 3.6 Certain Jimbol
  - 3.7 Certain Abel

#### **B. Actions Taken:**

- PCG Bantayan sought assistance from the crew of big vessels for the conduct of possible rescue
- PCG Bantayan will conduct Search and Rescue (SAR) operation as soon as the weather permits
- Naval Forces Central (NAVFORCEN) will assist PCG Bantayan in the conduct of SAR operation
- OCDRC VII closely monitors the situation for significant updates

### **II. Progress Report re Pre-emptive Evacuation Due to Strong Winds in Gingoog City, Misamis Oriental**

#### **A. Situation Overview:**

1. On or about 7:00 PM, 02 July 2015, strong winds were experienced in Barangays Binacalan, Samay, and Capitulangan in Gingoog City, Misamis Oriental
2. **A total of 66 families / 313 persons were displaced due to the incident**
3. **One (1) house in Barangay Samay and one (1) house in Barangay Tinabalan were partially damaged**

4. Electrical posts in Purok 1, Barangay Capitulangan were damaged and blocked the road connecting Barangay Binakalan and Barangay Capitulangan
5. The cost of damages is still undetermined
6. No casualties were reported in the incident

#### **B. Actions Taken:**

1. CDRRMO Gingoog City responded to the incident, conducted survey and gave safety inputs to the residents in the affected barangays
  2. OCD X continuously monitoring the incident
