I. Progress Report re Pre-emptive Evacuation Due to Strong Winds in Gingoog City, Misamis Oriental (Region X)

A. Situation Overview:

1. At about 7:00 PM, 02 July 2015, strong winds were experienced in Barangays Binacalan, Samay, and Capitulangan in Gingoog City, Misamis Oriental.

A total of 66 families / 313 persons were displaced due to the incident. All evacuees have 2. already returned to their houses.

Two (2) houses were partially damaged due to the incident (1- Brgy. Samay and 1- Brgy. Tinabalan).

- Electrical posts in Purok 1, Barangay Capitulangan were damaged and blocked the road connecting Barangay Binakalan and Barangay Capitulangan. The said road is already passable.
- The estimated cost of damages amounting to P20,000.00. No casualties were reported.

B. Actions Taken:

CDRRMO Gingoog City responded to the incident, conducted survey and gave safety inputs to the residents in the affected barangays.

2. CDRRMO, MORESCO II and concerned barangays conducted clearing operations and removed coconut trees blocking the road of Bray, Capitulangan,
