I. Initial Report re Landslide Incident in Caluya, Antique

A. Situation Overview:

- At about 3:00PM 17 July 2015, a landslide incident occurred at the mine site of Panian, Semirara Mining and Power Company (SMPC) in the Municipality of Caluya, Antique causing the portion of the mine site to collapse.

B. Effects:

- A total of six (6) workers of the said mining company were reported dead, three (3) are still missing and are believed to be buried, while five (5) were able to escape:

C. Actions Taken:

- MSWDO conducted counselling and psychosocial first aid interventions to the bereaved families
- All operations at the mine site have been suspended. Only rescue operations have been cleared to operate using heavy equipment
- Trained emergency responders of said mining company and LGUs have been deployed
- RDRRMC VI continuously monitors the situation and coordinates with SMPC for updates.
- OCD VI, together with TOG – 6, 3ID PA and LDRRMO conducted aerial survey

II. Fire Incident in Barangay Tandang Sora, Butuan City

A. Situation Overview:

- At 9:54PM, 16 July 2015, a fire occurred at P2, Villanueva Extension, Barangay Tandang Sora, Butuan City which was originated at the residence of Ms Jiji Aringca
- The incident was declared fire out at 11:54 PM
- More or less 100 structures were affected by the incident with an estimated cost of damage worth ₱10,000,000.00

B. Actions Taken:

- BFP Butuan City, Agusan Fil-Chinese Volunteer Fire Brigade Foundation, Inc., Gaisano Volunteer Fire Brigade, Water Tanker of Butuan City Government and other fire trucks from the neighboring City/Municipality Fire Stations were responded in the incident
- RDRRMC CARAGA continuously monitors the situation and coordinates with the City DRRMC of Butuan and BFP Butuan Station for updates

III. Spot Report for Mt. Bulusan, Sorsogon

A. Situation Overview:

- At 1:10 PM, 17 July 2015, PHIVOLCS recorded the explosion of Mt. Bulusan in Sorsogon Province with 200 meters height drifting west northwest.
- Subsequently, minor explosions were visible. Ashes were observed at Barangay Inlagadian, Casiguran in the said province.
- The extent of explosion and its corresponding effect to the local communities located adjacent to the volcano is being assessed by PHIVOLCS and LGUs concerned.

B. Actions Taken:

- RDRRMC V continues to coordinate with the PHIVOLCS, PDRRMO Sorsogon and LGUs concerned for the effects of recent ash explosion.

IV. Initial Report re Encounter between the AFP troops and NPA at Kibawe, Bukidnon

A. Situation Overview:

- At 11:45AM to 12:35PM 16 July 2015, an encounter between Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and New People's Army (NPA) occurred in P-3, Sitio Balagonon, Barangay Panimula, Kibawe, Bukidnon
- A total of fifty-three (53) families in Barangays Pinamual, Kisawa, and Sampaguita, all of Kibawe, Bukidnon were evacuated

B. Actions Taken:

- MDRRMC Kibawe provided food assistance to the affected families
