I. Progress Report re Food Poisoning in Sultan Kudarat

A. Situation Overview:

- At 4:00 PM, 19 July 2015, a food poisoning incident caused by contaminated macaroni salad occurred in Barangay Simuay, Sultan Kudarat, Maguindanao.

B. Effects:

- A total of thirty (30) persons were initially reported to have experienced signs and symptoms of food poisoning in which twelve (12) victims were rushed and treated to Cotabato Sanitarium Hospital, namely:

- As of 2:00 PM today, 21 July 2015, said victims were already in stable condition and five (5) of them were already discharged from the hospital. Hospital expenses were shouldered by Mayor Datu Shameen Mastura.

C. Actions Taken:

- MDRRMC – Sultan Kudarat and Sultan Kudarat Response Team brought the victims to the Cotabato Sanitarium Hospital in Sultan Kudarat for immediate medical care.
 - OCD –RDRRMC ARMM coordinated with MDRRMC-Sultan Kudarat for updates.
 - **MDRRMO Sultan Kudarat, MSWDO and MLGOO are still conducting further investigation on the incident.**
