I. Update on Vehicular Accident in Lipa City, Batangas

A. Situation Overview:

- At 6:15 AM, 21 July 2015, a vehicular accident occurred in Brgy. Tambo, Lipa City, Batangas involving five (5) vehicles:
 - o Isuzu Hi-Lander w/ plate no. VCN-831 (Vehicle 1)
 - o Toyota Hi-Ace Van w/ plate no. XJK-766 (Vehicle 2)
 - o PUJ w/ plate no. DWG-258 (Vehicle 3)
 - o Hyundai Tuczon w/ plate no. VFC-369 (Vehicle 4)
 - o Isuzu Cargo Truck w/ plate no. WPN-233 (Vehicle 5)
- All five (5) vehicles were heading to Lipa City. Upon reaching Tambo Barangay Hall, Lipa City, the brakes of vehicle 5 malfunctioned causing it to collide with the other vehicles. The collision caused vehicle 3 to swerve and hit pedestrians.
- It resulted to one (1) dead person and four (4) others injured:
