1. Update Report re Structural Fire Incident in Pagadian City as of 231700H July 2015

Situation Overview

- On or about 12:20 PM, 01 June 2015, a structural fire started near the Campo Islam elementary School at the back of Camp Islam Mosque, Brg. Santiago, Pagadian City. Due to the fast escalation of the fire, General Alarm was declared at about 1300H of same date by SINSIP Rheno P Cimafracia, IOC Provincial Fire Marshal of the Zamboanga del Sur – BFP, who was acting as the fire group commander of the incident. The fire was controlled on or about 1530H and a fire out was declared on or about 1623H of same date.
- Two (2) barangays of Pagadian City, namely San Pedro and Santiago, were heavily affected. A total of 2,005 families with 9,090 persons were evacuated in four evacuation centers of the City (Pagadian City Fish Port, San Pedro Central Elementary School, Pagadian City Gymnasium and Pagadian City Covered Court).
- As of this date, Pagadian City-DRRM Council is now conducting rehabilitation process and managing the evacuees located inside and outside evacuation centers. National and Local Government Agencies, NGOs, Private Individuals and Volunteers have also intervened to cater the needs and welfare of the affected people where majority are now located outside the evacuation centers. Based on the recent needs assessment conducted by the Pagadian City-DRRM office, the affected residents are asking for food assistance.

Actions Taken:

- OCD Region 9 is closely monitoring the situation for significant updates of the incident and for concerns that need immediate attention
- OCD Region 9 personnel have coordinated with the Pagadian City DRRMO and CSWDO to monitor the assistance (non-food and food items) that were provided to the fire victims and the other needs that were still not provided for
- OCD Region 9 is finalizing the preparation required for the relief operations (rice distribution) tentatively scheduled on 01 August 2015
- Members of the new established Regional IMT in the region were also invited to join aforementioned relief operations

II. Situational Report 1 re Whirlwind Destroyed Houses Incident in San Antonio, Quezon

A. Profile of the Incident

- Monitored DZMM newscast on or about 1700H 23 July 2015 disclosed that a whirlwind locally known as "BUHAWI" allegedly destroyed nine (9) houses somewhere in Quezon Province
- OCD Region IV-A immediately called up Quezon PDRRMO to verify the veracity of the report, however, it was only confirmed that said incident actually transpired in the municipality of San Antonio, Quezon
- Coordination is being made with San Antonio MDRRMO for other details

B. Actions Taken:

- OCD-RDRRMC IV-A coordinated with Quezon PDRRMO and San Antonio, MDRRMO regarding the Incident

III. Progress Report No. 1 on Bomb Explosion in Manly Massage Parlor, Zamboanga City

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 9:50 PM, 23 July 2015 an explosion transpired at Manly Massage Parlor, Ledesma St., Brgy. Zone I, Zamboanga City
- One (1) person died while ten (10) persons were reported injured and all were admitted to Zamboanga City Medical Center for treatment
- Type of explosion is still being investigated

B. Effects

- Casualties: One (1) Dead, ten (10) injured

C. Actions Taken:

- Responding Agencies were ZCPO-EOD, Central Police Station, Bomb Squad, Task Force-Zamboanga, RPSB (Regional Public Safety Battalion), BFP, Phil. Marines, Red Cross and ZCMC-HEMS
 - Intensified check/chode points by Task Force Zamboanga and ZCPO and Central Police Station
 - OCD Region 9 OpCen is continuously monitoring the situation for any development of the incident and a BLUE ALERT Status for the purpose
