1. Destructive Whirlwind in San Antonio, Quezon (Region IV-A)

A. Situation Overview

 At 2:45 PM, 22 July 2015, a strong wind with hail and stones was experienced in Barangays Del Valle, Callejon, Sintorisan, and Briones in the municipality of San Antonio, Province of Quezon

B. Effects

- The incident damaged a total of eight (8) houses in Barangays Del Valle and Briones (6 and 2 houses, respectively); two (2) classrooms of Sintorisan Elementary School and 10 hectares of rice field
- No reported casualty

C. Actions Taken:

 OCD-RDRRMC IV-A coordinated with Quezon PDRRMO and San Antonio, MDRRMO regarding the Incident

2. Food Poisoning Incident in Calamba City, Laguna (Region IV-A)

A. Situation Overview:

- On 2:00 PM, 24 July 2015, a food poisoning incident occurred at Real Elementary School in Calamba City, Laguna involving around 228 pupils in the 3rd and 4th grade
- It was reported that the City College of Calamba sponsored a feeding program as part of the Nutrition Month Celebration. Cupcakes and ice candies were distributed and served to the children which may have caused the poisoning

B. Effects

 A total of <u>247 pupils</u> were brought to nearby hospitals for immediate medical treatment:

C. Actions Taken:

- PNP Calamba is on-site conducting investigation and will also conduct investigation to the City College Calamba staff and students
- Calamba CDRRM Council was convened for a meeting to discuss the incident and identify interventions to be undertaken including the arrest of the alleged perpetrators
- Calamba CSWD visited the victims at the hospital to check their medical condition and necessary assistance needed
- OCD IV-A is in continuous coordination with Calamba City, Public Order and Safety Office (POSO) / CDRRMO, DOH IV-A and DSWD IV-A
- DSWD IV-A is in close coordination with Calamba CSWDO for possible augmentation of medical needs of the victims

Progress Report No. 02 on Bomb Explosion in Manly Massage Parlor, Zamboanga City (Region IX)

A. Situation Overview:

- At 9:50 PM, 23 July 2015, an explosion transpired at Manly Massage Parlor, Ledesma St., Brgy. Zone I, Zamboanga City
- It resulted to one (1) dead person and ten (10) others injured, all were admitted to Zamboanga City Medical Center for treatment
- Post blast investigation revealed that the explosion was caused by a composition of Ammonium Nitrate Fuel Oil (ANFO) and that nails recovered in the blast site suggests that the latter was used to enhance the blast effects

B. Effects

- Casualties
 - One (1) dead a certain Geraldine Miguel who died at the hospital while undergoing treatment
 - > Ten (10) injured, names are as follows:

C. Actions Taken:

- Responding Agencies were ZCPO-EOD, Central Police Station, Bomb Squad, Task Force-Zamboanga, RPSB (Regional Public Safety Batallion), BFP, Phil. Marines, Red Cross, and ZCMC-HEMS
- Intensified check/choke points by Task Force Zamboanga and ZCPO and Central Police Station

 OCD Region IX OpCen is in continuous monitoring of the situation for any development of the incident and a BLUE ALERT Status for the purpose

4. Fire Incident in Poblacion, Muntinlupa City (NCR)

A. Situation Overview:

- At 4:55 PM, 23 July 2015, a fire incident transpired in a residential area at Sacristia St., Poblacion, Muntinlupa City
- The fire reached 3rd alarm and was declared fire out at 7:17 PM of the same day
- According to investigation, the fire started from the residence of a certain Elvira Z. Nicolas which affected a total of seventy-one (71) families and around forty-eight (48) houses damaged

B. Effects

- Estimated cost of damages was pegged at PhP3,000,000.00
- Two (2) were reported injured, names are as follows:
 - o Marissa Navarro, 55 y/o
 - o Jose Fontanilla, 61 y/o

C. Actions Taken:

- Muntinlupa Fire Department responded to the incident
- OCD NCR coordinated with Muntinlupa BFP
