### **1. Structural Fire Incident at Tayabas City, Quezon (Region IV-A)**

#### **A. Situation Overview**

- Around 10:00 AM, 25 July 2015, a fire broke out at Angeles Zone 1, Tayabas City.
- Spot investigation disclosed that on 9:15 AM of the same day, a mountaineer informed Tayabas Fire Station that a fire incident is ongoing at Brgy. Angeles Zone 1 at the back of Tayabas City Public Market.
- The aforesaid fire incident originated from the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of a residential house.
- The fire was declared under control at 10:35 AM and was subsequently declared fire out at 10:45 AM by the ground commander.
- The cause of fire is still under investigation

#### **B. Effects:**

- As a result, a total of 2 persons were injured namely:

NAME	INJURY SUSTAINED
1. Ebeneser Cablaida	One (1) inch laceration on the left foot
2. Mary Ann Agudilla	Hip injury as a result of jumping from the 10 ft wall

- More or less fifty (50) houses were affected. While the total estimated cost of damages amounted to more or less Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (PHP3, 500,000.00).

#### **C. Actions Taken:**

- BFP Mauban, Pagbilao, Lucban, Candelaria, and Tayabas together with the volunteer fire fighters from Sales Gas and Chinese Volunteers responded on the incident.
- Provincial Fire Marshal of BFP – Quezon acted as the fire ground commander.

- BFP Tayabas City is still investigating the cause of fire, area, extent of damage, and affected families.
  - OCD-RDRRMC IV-A is closely coordinating with response agencies and Quezon PDRMO for updates on the incident.
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
