1. Initial Report re Flashflood Incident in Tulunan, Cotabato Province

A. Situation Overview

- At 2:00 AM, 30 July 2015, a flashflood incident occurred due to heavy rains in three (3) barangays: La Esperanza; Poblacion, and; Sibsib, all in the Municipality of Tulunan, Cotabato Province.
- The flashflood displaced a total of 93 families and partially damaged rice fields.
- Displaced families temporarily evacuated to higher ground within their barangay and have already returned to their homes after flood water subsided were thirty-five (35) families from Brgy. La Esperanza, nineteen (19) families from Brgy. Poblacion, and thirty-nine (39) families from Brgy. Sibsib.

B. Effects:

C. Actions Taken:

- MDRRMC-Tulunan deployed Search and Rescue team to affected areas for preemptive evacuation and a RDANA team to assess the situation and the needs of the affected families.
- MWSD-Tulunan Office distributed family food packs.
- LGU-Tulunan provided tarpaulin for displaced families.
