1. Flashflood in San Fernando, Bukidnon

A. Situation Overview

- At 4:00 PM, 31 July 2015, a flashflood incident occurred in Barangay Sto. Domingo, San Fernando, Bukidnon due to continuous rains.

B. Effects:

- A family of ten (10) was evacuated in Sto. Domingo, Barangay Hall.
- The house of the affected family was partially damaged.
- To date, the main road of Barangay Sto. Domingo is impassable.
- No casualties were reported in the incident.

C. Actions Taken:

- LGU San Fernando provided food and non-food items to the affected family.
- OCD X coordinated with MDRRMC San Fernando for updates on the incident.

2. Flooding in Maguindanao

A. Situation Overview

- On 01 August 2015, flooding incidents were reported in the Municipalities of Pagalungan, Datu Montawal, and Paglat in the Province of Maguindanao due to continuous rains.
- As of 3:55 PM, 02 August 2015, flooding in the Municipalities of Pagalungan and Datu Montawal has already subsided.
- No casualties and population displacement were reported in the affected areas.

B. Actions Taken:

- OCD ARMM, RDRRMC ARMM, and ARMM HEART continue to monitor the low-lying and perennially flooded municipalities in the province.
