1. Effects of ITCZ in Regions IX and X

The Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) started to affect Mindanao on 28 July 2015, with isolated thunderstorms, occasional light to moderate rains and winds affecting Regions IX and X. As a result, the following incidents have been reported and monitored:

1. Uprooted Acacia Tree in Zamboanga City (Region IX)

- a. Around 4:00 PM, 02 August 2015, an Acacia tree blocked the road along Labuan National Road.
- b. Temporary power outage was reported in the area due to toppled power lines. Electricity was restored two hours after the incident.
- c. No casualty or damage to property were reported

Actions Taken:

- a. Sinubong Barangay DRRM conducted traffic re-routing and clearing operations in Zamboanga City
- b. Zamboanga City Electric Cooperative (ZAMCELCO) immediately responded to the area to repair the damaged electric lines and restored electricity after two (2) hours

2. Capsized MV "LCT Emilia 2" in the Municipality of Tabina, Zamboanga del Sur (Region IX)

- a. Around 4:00 PM, 02 August 2015, a Motor Vessel, MV "LCT Emilia 2", with 15 crew members aboard capsized while at the vicinity of around 1.5 nautical miles, Southeast off the seawaters of Baganian Peninsula, Tabina, Zamboanga del Sur.
- b. The aforesaid motor vessel from Cotabato was bound for Lamitan City when it encountered engine trouble and was hit by big waves causing it to capsize.
- c. The Chief Mate identified as Nashruddin Ayunan was reported dead and 14 crew members including the skipper were rescued namely:

Actions Taken:

- a. OCD IX verified the information with the Coast Guard Pagadian Station re the capsized vessel
- b. Tabina Mayor Dayondon immediately activated and deployed the SAR Team
- c. Tabina Search and Rescue (SAR) Team rescued the 14 crew members
- d. SAR Team from Coast Guard Pagadian and OCD personnel assisted in the SAR operations
- e. Tabina-DRRMC brought the survivors to the house of the Mayor for assistance
- f. OCD IX coordinated with ZDS-PDRRM, Tabina-MDRRM and Coast Guard for information and updates on the incident

3. Initial Report re Flashflood Incident at Malaybalay City, Bukidnon (Region X)

- a. At 10:00 PM, 03 August 2015, a flashflood incident transpired at Purok 4 Lalawan, Brgy. Linabo, Malaybalay City, Bukidnon due to heavy rains brought by the Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).
- b. As a result thereof, a total of 12 families/52 persons evacuated at Brgy. Linabo covered court.

Action Taken:

- a. The CDRRMO personnel composed of two (2) teams instantly proceeded to the area and conducted immediate evacuation.
