I. Effects of ITCZ

A. Progress Report No. 1 Region X

Situation Overview

- a. At 2:30 PM, 04 August 2015, flashflood incidents occurred due to heavy rains brought about by the effects of ITCZ and Southwest Monsoon in Region X.
- b. Pre-emptive evacuation was carried out on Sitio Panamukan, San Jose, Malaybalay City, Bukidnon due to heavy rains experienced caused by ITCZ. A total of 16 families/100 persons were affected and sheltered at the San Jose Elementary School, Malaybalay City, Bukidnon.
- c. Pre-emptive evacuation was carried out at Barangay Poblacion, Valencia City, Bukidnon with 83 families/378 persons were evacuated to the Valencia City Gymnasium.
- d. In Valencia City, there is one (1) injured and seven (7) missing persons reported, as follows:

Injured: One (1) injured, 6 month old child of Mr. & Mrs Eddie Eroisa (exact name of child to be determined as parents are also missing) from Brgy Poblacion who was brought to Laviña General Hospital;

Missing: Seven (7) persons

- e. Power, water, communications are reported to be in normal condition; and roads and bridges are all passable.

f. A total of forty-one (41) houses in Brgy Poblacion, Valencia City, Bukidnon have been reported to have been damaged (5 totally damaged, 36 partially damaged). Cost of damage has yet to be determined.

Actions Taken:

- a. The CDRRMO Malaybalay assisted the affected families in the pre-emptive evacuation and coordinated with the CSWD for the distribution of food packs.
- b. The CDRRMO Valencia conducted rescue operations.
- c. CDRRMO Valencia-Relief supplies were provided to the flood victims temporarily sheltered at the City Gymnasium.

B. Flashflood in Sultan Kudarat, Maguindanao (ARMM)

Situation Overview

- g. At 2:00 PM, 04 August 2015, Barangays Mulaog and Banubo of Sultan Kudarat experienced flashfloods due to intermittent light to heavy rains for the past few days caused by ITCZ affecting especially Mindanao.
- h. To date, there are no reported casualties and population displacement in that area.

C. Flooding Incident in Sultan Mastura, Maguindanao (ARMM)

Situation Overview

a. Flooding started from 30 July 2015 until 03 August 2015, as a result of intermittent light to heavy rains.

Effects

- a. Barangay Solon was affected resulting to the evacuation of 39 families.
- b. Cut-Off Channel Dike along Simuay River was destroyed but cost of damage is still being determined by DPWH

Actions Taken:

a. OCD/RDRRMC-ARMM/HEART is pursuing constant coordination with MDRRMOs concerned as well as with PDRRMO-Maguindanao on flooding and other incidents that may occur in the province due to the prevailing ITCZ situation.

II. Lightning Incident in Brgy. Caguray, Magsaysay, Occidental Mindoro

On 2 August 2015, on or about 2:00PM, a lightning incident occurred in Brgy Caguray, Magsaysay, Occidental Mindoro. The victim, Mr. Manny Ciongco Alvarez, 29 years old, single, farmer and a resident at said barangay, was feeding his carabao along the barangay road when he was struck by lightning and sustained multiple burned injuries in different parts of his body that caused his death.

III. Belated Report on Whirlwind Incident in Carmen, Cotabato

Situation Overview

On July 22, 2015 at 3:00 PM, heavy rains associated with strong winds occurred in two (2) barangays of aforesaid municipality affecting 117 families.

Actions Taken:

- a. MDRRMC distributed family food packs to the affected families
- MDRRMC in coordination with the respective BDRRMCs conducted assessment and validation on the affected area.
