### **1. Flooding Incidents due to Effects of Southwest Monsoon in Maguindanao**

#### **Situation Overview:**

- Flooding incidents occurred due to intermittent light to heavy rains as an effect of southwest monsoon affecting 70 barangays of 8 municipalities in the Province of Maguindanao, namely: Ampatuan; Datu Salibo; Northern Kabuntalan; Mother Kabuntalan; Sultan Kudarat; Sultan Mastura; Datu Montawal; and Datu Piang.
- As of reporting time, there are no reports of casualties, population displacement and evacuation taking place.

#### **Affected Population**

- A total of 12,340 families/60,700 persons were affected by knee-deep floodwaters in the following municipalities:

#### **Actions Taken:**

- RDRRMC-ARMM continuously monitoring and coordinating with concerned MDRRMOs on effects of intermittent rains in their area of responsibility.
- Field assessment/validation is ongoing at the regional level regarding flooded municipalities.
- OCD-ARMM through SMART Infoboard disseminated PAGASA weather updates to all stakeholders every 6 hours.

- d. DSWD-ARMM, PSWDO-Maguindanao, PNP and AFP are place on standby to provide relief/response assistance and security if needed.
- e. DOTC-ARMM continuously provides advisories for fishing boats and other seacrafts to avoid sailing due to rough sa conditions.

## 2. Progress Report No. 4 re Effects of ITCZ in Region X.

### Situation Overview:

- a. At 2:30 PM, 04 August 2015, flashflood incident occurred due to heavy rains as an effect of ITCZ and Southwest Monsoon in Region X.

### Effects:

- a. A total of nine (9) casualties were reported (**8 dead, 1 missing**), as follows:

## b. Affected Population

A total of **426 families/ 1,085 persons** were affected. Of this number, **372 families/880 persons** were evacuated:

- A total of forty-one (41) houses in Brgy Poblacion, Valencia City, Bukidnon have been reported to have been damaged (5 totally damaged, 36 partially damaged). Cost of damage has yet to be determined.
- Power, water, communications are reported to be in normal condition.
- All roads and bridges are passable.

## Actions Taken:

- The CDRRMO Malaybalay assisted the affected families in the conduct of pre-emptive evacuation and coordinated with the CSWD for the distribution of food packs.
- CDRRMO Valencia provided relief supplies to the flood victims who were temporarily sheltered at the City Gymnasium.
- Valencia City local government provided financial assistance amounting to Php10,000.00 each to the bereaved family of the dead victims.
- Alert Status in OCD Region 10 OPCEN is raised to Blue Alert.
- Region 10 PDRA Core Team convened and discussed the possible tracks and effects of Typhoon Hanna on the ITCZ and SW Monsoon in Region 10.**
- Search and rescue operations were collaboratively conducted by PDRRMC-Bukidnon, CDRRMC- Valencia City, BDRRMCs – Poblacion, Guinuyoran, and Tugaya, PNP and Task Force Valencia.
