I. Effects of ITCZ

A. Progress Report No. 3 Region X

Situation Overview:

 At 2:30 PM, 04 August 2015, flashflood incident occurred due to heavy rains as an effect of ITCZ and Southwest Monsoon in Region X.

Effects:

a. A total of nine (9) casualties were reported (7 dead, 2 missing), as follows:

b. Affected Population

A total of 426 families/1,085 persons were affected. Of this number, 372 families/880 persons were evacuated:

- c. A total of forty-one (41) houses in Brgy Poblacion, Valencia City, Bukidnon have been reported to have been damaged (5 totally damaged, 36 partially damaged). Cost of damage has yet to be determined.
- d. Power, water, communications are reported to be in normal condition.
- e. All roads and bridges are passable.

Actions Taken:

- a. The CDRRMO Malaybalay assisted the affected families in the conduct of preemptive evacuation and coordinated with the CSWD for the distribution of food packs.
- b. CDRRMO Valencia provided relief supplies to the flood victims who were temporarily sheltered at the City Gymnasium.
- c. Valencia City local government provided financial assistance amounting to Php10,000.00 each to the bereaved family of the dead victims.
- d. Alert Status in OCD Region 10 OPCEN is raised to Blue Alert.

e. Search and rescue operations were collaboratively conducted by PDRRMC-Bukidnon, CDRRMC- Valencia City, BDRRMCs – Poblacion, Guinuyoran, and Tugaya, PNP and Task Force Valencia.

B. Landslide Incident in Kidapawan City (Region XII)

Situation Overview:

a. On 04 August 2015, landslide incidents occurred in Sitios Sudsuhayon, Sayaban, and Agco, all of Kidapwan City which rendered roads temporarily not passable. As of reporting time, affected roads are now passable.

Actions Taken:

- a. Kidapawan City LGU conducted clearing operations.
- b. CDRRMC Kidapawan City conducted assessment and aerial survey of areas affected by landslide
- c. PDRRMC Cotabato coordinated with CDRRMC Kidapawan for assistance needed
