## **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW**

Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affected Regions VII, X, and ARMM since 30 July 2015 until 05 August 2015. Moderate to occasionally heavy rainshowers and thunderstorms were experienced resulting to flashfloods, landslides, and flooding especially in the low-lying areas.

## **II. EFFECTS**

### **A. Incidents Monitored**

#### **1. Landslide/Flashflood Incidents in Jagna, Bohol (Region VII)**

- Around 1:00 AM to 10:00 AM, 4 August 2015, landslide/erosion and flashfloods incidents occurred due to nine (9) hours of non-stop heavy rains in the Municipality of Jagna, Bohol affecting eight (8) barangays, namely: Cabungaan, Canjulao, Cambugason, Pagina, Pangdan, Poblacion, Tejero and Tubod Monte. No casualties are reported.

#### **2. Flashflood Incident in Valencia City, Bukidnon (Region X)**

- Around 2:30 PM, 04 August 2015, a flashflood incident occurred in Valencia City, Bukidnon due to heavy rains and isolated thunderstorms resulting to the deaths of nine (9) people.

#### **3. Flooding Incident in Municipalities of Maguindanao (ARMM)**

- Since 30 July 2015, intermittent rains resulted to flooding in eight (8) municipalities of Maguindanao. No casualties were reported.

### **B. Affected Population**

1. **As of 09 August 2015**, a total of **13,020 families/ 62,929 persons** were affected in **82 barangays** of Regions VII, X and ARMM. Of which, **102 families/ 510 persons** were evacuated:

## II. ACTIONS TAKEN

### A. REGION VII

- a. Recommended to all Chairpersons of LDRRMCs to conduct pre-emptive evacuation on high risk areas as necessary

### **MDRRMC Jagna**

- a. Activated its Command Center to monitor the effects of heavy rains, flashfloods and landslide/erosion.
- b. On alert status and continuously monitors the situation
- c. Conducted the following:
  - Clearing operations of uprooted trees along roadways declogging canals
  - Evacuated school children to safer grounds
  - Installed early warning devices to landslide affected roads
  - Distributed relief goods to affected families
  - Conducted rapid damage and needs assessment in all affected barangays

## **B. REGION X**

- a. Deployed RDRRMC RDANA Team at Valencia City, Bukidnon on 07 August 2015

### **OCD X**

- a. Conducted PDRA Core Group Meeting on 06 August 2015
- b. Operations Center is raised to Blue Alert effective 05 August 2015

### **PDRRMC Bukidnon**

- a. Conducted Search and Rescue operations together with CDRRMC-Valencia City, BDRRMCs – Poblacion, Guinuyoran, and Tugaya, PNP and Task Force Valencia

### **CDRRMC Malaybalay**

- a. Conducted pre-emptive evacuation and coordinated with the CSWD for the distribution of food packs

### **CDRRMC Valencia**

- a. Provided relief supplies to the flood victims who were temporarily sheltered at the City Gymnasium.
- b. Provided financial assistance to the bereaved family of the dead victims amounting to ₱10,000.00 each.

## **C. ARMM**

### **OCD ARMM**

- a. Conducted field validation/ocular inspection of flooded municipalities in the province
- b. Continuous monitoring and in coordination with RDRRMC-ARMM/HEART, concerned MDRRMO and PDRRMO-Maguindanao

### **MDRRMCs Ampatuan, Datu Salibo, Northern Kabuntalan, Kabuntalan (Mother), Sultan Kudarat, Sultan Mastura, Datu Montawal and Datu Piang**

- a. Municipal DRRMOs of above LGUs are still assessing the status of flood-affected population and damages in agriculture as well as properties, infrastructure and other facilities
