### **1. Vehicular Accident in Quezon City**

#### **A. Situation Overview**

- On 12 August 2015, 7:14 AM, a vehicular accident involving a passenger bus has occurred along Quirino Highway, Lagro, Quezon City near the boundary of Caloocan City.
- A total of four (4) individuals were reported dead and 17 were injured:

## **2. Initial Report re Fire Incident in Bongao, Tawi-Tawi**

### **A. Situation Overview**

- At about 4:00 AM, 13 August 2015, a fire broke out in Barangay Tubig Tanah, Bongao, Tawi-Tawi affecting ten (10) houses.
- No casualties were reported to date.

### **B. Actions Taken**

- BFP Bongao responded to the incident.
