## **NDRRMC UPDATE**

**1. Report re Missing Fishermen from Liloan, Southern Leyte - from OCDRC8 dated 21 August 2015 (Source: OCD VIII)**

### **A. Situational Background**

- At around 200900H August 2015, a report was received by CGSS Liloan from Mrs. Angelita Beltran, Chairwoman, Brgy. San Roque, Liloan, Southern Leyte and Mrs. Roselyn Cero, wife of Brgy. Kagawad that three (3) fishermen on board an unidentified fishing MBCA was allegedly dead in waters off Brgy, Caligangan, Liloan, Southern Leyte.
- At around 201000H August 2015, PCG personnel departed to verify report and conduct SAR operation along sea waters off Cabalian Bay to San Ricardo, Southern Leyte that yielded no result. Operation was terminated around 1800H same day.
- At around 2100H same day, PCG sub-station received another info from Mrs. Cero indentifying the missing banca as MBCA Prince with the following on board:
  - Mr. Pilarito Monghit, male, 47 years old
  - Billy Jay Monghit, male, 24 years old
  - Romeo Lupas, male, 48 years old (all from Brgy. San Roque)
- At around 210800H August 2015, PCG sub-station Liloan received a call from Mrs. Cero that MBCA Prince has drifted at Kanihaan Island, Dinagat Province where the three fishermen safely took shelter. This information came from Mr. Larry Monghit, who was called by his father, Pilarito Monghit, that they were on said island at around 202200H August 2015.
- At around 210815H August 2015, PCG personnel along with Mrs. Cero proceeded to Kahinaan Island aboard FB Jedils and FB Irish Jun to pick up the three (3) survivors.
- At around 211230H August 2015, PCG arrived at Dinagat Island and saw that the three (3) survivors are alive and in good condition under the custody of Hon. Janiel B. Gemao, Brgy. Chairman of Brgy. Kanihaan.

## **B. Actions Taken**

- LGU-Liloan, Southern Leyte coordinated with PCG-Liloan, PDRRMO-Southern Leyte and OCD-RDRRMC for the rescue of three (3) survivors.
- PDRRMO-Southern Leyte coordinated with concerned agency for the conduct of rescue.
- PCG Sub-Station Liloan, Southern Leyte led the overall coordination and actual rescue efforts.
- OCD-VIII coordinated closely with MDRRMO-Liloan, PDRRMO-Southern Leyte, and PCG-Liloan and coordinated with all concerned agencies, LGUs, and DRRMOs for verification of reports and conduct of rescue operation; coordinated with PDRRMO-Southern Leyte for verification of report; closely monitoring of the incident. Sent an OCDVIII personnel to coordinate rescue efforts on 21 August 2015
- Monitor final report of the incident by the concerned agencies.

## **2. Incident Report re Fire at Angkop St. Malugay Compound, Brgy. San Martin de Porres, Parañaque City - from OCDNCR dated 21 August 2015 (source BFP Parañaque)**

### **A. Situational Background**

- At around 201741H August 2015, a fire broke out involving more or less 100 residential houses at Angkop St. Malugay Compound, Brgy. San Martin de Porres, Parañaque City. The fire reached TF Echo at 1939H of the same day. At 2232H, fire was declared under control and by 0044H of 21 August 2015, fire out was declared.
- Fire affected more or less 300 families, no injuries have been reported with estimated damages amounting to more or less Php3,000,000.00
- Parañaque City BFP and fire volunteers responded to the incident. Cause of fire is still under investigation

### **B. Actions Taken**

- Coordinated with BFP Parañaque City and requested for Spot Report
  - Prepared and submitted report to NDRRMC OpCen.
