1. Oil Spill Incident in the Province of Rizal

A. Situation Overview:

- 1. On or about 12:05 AM, 08 September 2015, MDRRMO Teresa, Rizal informed MDRRMO Morong regarding an oil spill at the Teresa River and inquired if the spill reached Morong River.
- 2. MDRRMO Morong conducted investigation and instructed Barangay Chairmen to monitor the river situation.
- 3. At about 5:15 AM, on the same date, MDRRMO Morong alerted the Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) Station Laguna de Bay to verify the oil spill on Teresa River.
- Upon investigation, the PCG team noticed approximately 2,000 liters of bunker oil are floating on the river which came from Solid Cement Corporation located at Sitio Tagbac, Barangay San Jose, Antipolo City.
- 5. At 10:18 AM, on the same date, small traces of oil spill were detected at the Morong River, Poblacion, and adjacent tributaries.
- 6. Three (3) oil spill booms were positioned by Solid Cement Corporation at the vicinity of Barangay May-Iba, Teresa, Rizal.

B. Effects:

 According to the initial report of the Morong Municipal Agriculture Officer (MAO), a total of 25 hectares of rice field cannot be irrigated from the river source, of which, 20 hectares were from Barangay San Guillermo and five (5) hectares were from Barangay Bombongan.

C. Actions Taken:

- 1. LDRRMO Teresa and Morong established a monitoring network through barangay chairmen, farmers, and fisherfolks to continuously monitor the situation in the rivers and their tributaries.
- 2. PCG deployed investigation and monitoring teams in the affected rivers and tributaries.
- 3. PCG deployed two (2) aluminium boats at Morong River.

2. Belated Report re Food Poisoning Incident in South Cotabato

A. Situation Overview:

- On 30 August 2015, members of a religious organization celebrated their anniversary in Sitio Lemkagang, Barangay Takunel, Lake Sebu, South Cotabato.
- 2. The members were served with pancit bihon prepared by volunteers for lunch.

B. Effects:

- 1. At about 4:00 PM, on the same date, 69 individuals were brought to Lake Sebu Municipal Community Hospital due to headache, fever, abdominal pain, vomiting, and loose bowel movement.
- 2. A total of 33 individuals were admitted and discharged the next day while 36 were discharged on the same date.

C. Actions Taken:

- MDRRMO Lake Sebu assisted the victims and facilitated their transport to the hospital.
- 2. OCD XII is closely monitoring the situation for updates.

3. Initial Report re Internal Displacement in Sultan Kudarat

A. Situation Overview:

 On or about 4:00 AM, 09 September 2015, residents of Barangays Bayasong and Simsiman in Lutayan, Sultan Kudarat evacuated and sought temporary shelter to a safer location within their respective barangays due to an alleged armed conflict.

B. Effects:

1. A total of 373 families / 1,865 individuals evacuees were reported in Barangay Bayasong while 422 families / 2,110 individuals were reported in Barangay Simsiman.

C. Actions Taken:

- LGU Lutayan continuously monitors the affected families in the evacuation areas.
- 2. OCD XII is closely monitoring the situation for updates.
