1. Progress Report re Bomb Explosion in Zamboanga City (Region IX)

#### A. Situation Overview:

At 2:20 PM, 18 September 2015, an improvised explosive device (IED) exploded inside a Biel Bus Transit with Body No. 1641 and registered plate number JVN 978 along Thomas Claudio Street, Zamboanga City.

#### B. Effects:

- Initial casualties reported include one (1) dead person and thirty-four (34) others injured, with nine (9) brought to the Zamboanga City Medical Center, while the rest sustained injuries but were not admitted.
- 2. Dead person is identified as Fatima Alifara Imbraida, 11 y/o, female, from Sibuco, Zamboanga Del Norte.

#### C. Actions Taken:

- 1. OCDRC IX is continuously coordinating and monitoring the situation.
- ZCPO-EOD, Central Police Station, Bomb Squad, Task Force-Zamboanga, Regional Public Safety Battalion (RPSB), BFP, Philippine Marines, Red Cross and ZCMC-HEMS responded to the incident.
- Task Force Zamboanga, ZCPO and Central Police Station intensified check points.
- Zamboanga City Police Office identified Ammonium Nitrate as the type of the explosive device used.
- 2. Belated Report re Local Thunderstorm at Purok 6, Sitio Araneta, Kahaponan, Valencia City (Region X)

#### A. Situation Overview:

 At 8:30 PM, 18 September 2015, a local thunderstorm occurred at Purok 6, Sitio Araneta, Kahaponan, Valencia City (Region X).

#### B. Effects:

- 1. Two (2) families were reported affected, while two (2) houses and one (1) mini auditorium were partially damaged. No reported casualty.
- 2. Estimated cost of damage is still to be determined.

#### C. Actions Taken:

1. CDRRMC rescue personnel and Hon. Maria Deliza C. Veriales responded to the incident and conducted ocular survey in the area.
