1. Progress Report re Local Thunderstorm at Purok 6, Sitio Araneta, Kahaponan, Valencia City, Bukidnon

A. Situation Overview:

1. At 8:30 PM, 18 September 2015, a local thunderstorm occurred at Purok 6, Sitio Araneta, Kahaponan, Valencia City, Bukidnon.

B. Effects:

- 1. Three (3) families or twelve (12) persons were reported affected, while three (3) houses were partially damaged worth P4,500.00. No reported casualty.
- 2. Estimated cost of damage to government building worth P252,000.00.

C. Actions Taken:

- CDRRMC rescue personnel and Hon. Maria Deliza C. Veriales responded to the incident and conducted ocular survey in the area.
- 2. OCD RO X conducted Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (DANA)

2. Initial Report re Strong Winds in the Municipality of Tupi, South Cotabato

A. Situation Overview:

2. At 1:45 PM, 21 September 2015, a strong wind with heavy rainfall hit Barangay Kablon, Tupi, South Cotabato

B. Effects:

 Twenty-three (23) individuals/vendors were reported affected, while their stalls made of light materials were severely damaged due to said incident.

C. Actions Taken:

- 1. MDRRMC Tupi immediately responded and conducted damage assessment in the
- OCD RO XII continuously monitoring the situation and coordinating with the MDRRMO

3. Initial Report re Flashflood Incident in Pagadian City

A. Situation Overview:

 At 4:00 PM, 21 September 2015, a flashflood and landslide incident brought about by the ITCZ occurred in Barangays Tiguma, Tuburan, and Balintawak, all of Pagadian City

B. Casualty:

1. One (1) unidentified victim was buried by landslide and declared dead upon arrival by the attending physician at the Jamilarin Hospital, Pagadian City

C. Effects:

1. More or less two hundred (200) houses were affected by the said incident

D. Actions Taken:

- Pagadian City DRRMO, City Press Bureau, City DILG, City Traffic Management and PNP Traffic together with the Barangay Official conducted assessment in the affected barangays
- 2. OCD RO IX immediately coordinated with the Pagadian City DRRMO for any assistance needed in the area.
- 3. OCD RO IX is continuously monitoring with Pagadian City DRRMO for any development
