1. Dengue Outbreak in Cavite Province (REGION IV-A)

A. Situation Overview:

 At 8:00 AM, 22 September 2015, Cavite province was declared under the State of Calamity due to dengue outbreak.

B. Effects:

1. A total of 4,137 suspected dengue cases were reported in twenty (20) municipalities and three (3) cities in the Province of Cavite as of 12 September 2015.

C. Actions Taken:

- DOH-HEMS IV-A Dengue Program already sent 150 bottles of Dengue Adultiscide-Whopees approved to the Province of Cavite.
- Cavite Provincial Council authorized the release of ₱12,000,000.00 of the Province's Calamity Fund.
- 3. OCD-RDRRMC IV-A is continuously coordinating with PDRRMC Cavite and DOH HEMS IV-A for close monitoring and update on the actions need to be taken.

2. Belated Report re Soil Erosion in Dumalag, Capiz (REGION VI)

A. Situation Overview:

 At 7:00 PM, 20 September 2015, a soil erosion was reported in Sitio Malitbog, Brgy. Dolores, Dumalag, Capiz.

B. Effects:

 Approximately 200 metric tons of soil covered the two (2) lanes of the National Road and only a single motorcycle can pass the road.

C. Actions Taken:

- MDRRMC Dumalag, CERT, BFP, PNP, and Brgy. Tanod started clearing operations on 20 September 2015
- 2. OCD RO VI continuously monitoring the situation and coordinating with the MDRRMC.
