**I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

**The Tropical Depression "KABAYAN" has slightly accelerated and intensified as it moves in a northwest direction.**

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 200 km diameter of the tropical depression.
- Moderate to occasionally heavy rains and isolated thunderstorms will be experienced over **Metro Manila, Central Luzon, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, Bicol Region, and Western Visayas.**
- The public and the disaster risk reduction and management council concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

## II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- **NDRRMC Operations Center** disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 02** re **Tropical Depression “KABAYAN”** to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
  - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
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
