1. Bomb Explosion Incident in Polomolok, South Cotabato

A. Situation Overview:

1. Around 12:00 noon, 01 October 2015, a bombing explosion incident occurred inside a Yellow Bus Line with body number 2008 while traversing Brgy. Silway 7, Polomolok, South Cotabato. The said bus was bound for General Santos City from Koronadal City.

B. Effects:

1. A total 19 passengers suffered injuries due to the said incident, of which two (2) persons were confined at St. Elizabeth Hospital, General Santos City and five (5) others in General Santos Doctors' Hospital, General Santos City.

C. Actions Taken:

1. Polomolok Emergency Rescue Team and General Rescue 727 responded to the incident and gave first aid to victims who were then brought to nearest hospitals in General Santos City.
2. General Santos Police, Polomolok Police, and Task Force General Santos were deployed to secure the incident area.
3. Traffic Unit Volunteers were also deployed by General Santos City to manage traffic flow.
4. Scene of the Crime Operatives (SOCO) team responded to the incident to process and identify the explosive used.
5. OCD XII Regional Director and its staff responded to the area to assess and monitor the situation.

2. Initial Report re Bombing Incident in Isabela City, Basilan

D. Situation Overview:

1. Around 1:15 PM, 01 October 2015, a bombing incident occurred at National Highway, Brgy. Sunrise, Isabela City in front of the City Mayor's residence. As a result thereof, three vehicles were damaged, specifically, Toyota Hi-lux with plate number WTO 656, Toyota Hi-ace with plate number AEA 4365, and a motor vehicle with plate number 6728 NU.
2. Furthermore, the convoy of the City Vice-Mayor who at that moment was traversing the aforementioned highway was also hit by the said unknown improvised explosive device.

E. Effects:

1. A total of four (4) persons were reported dead while six (6) others suffered injuries due to the said incident who were brought to the nearest hospital:

F. Actions Taken:

1. Isabela City Medical Team responded to the incident and brought the victims to the nearest hospitals.
 2. Explosive and Ordinance Division (EOD) of Isabela City Police Office is conducting investigation on the type of explosive used, identities and motives of the suspects/perpetrators.
 3. OCD Region IX is continuously monitoring the situation for significant updates.
