1. Initial Report re Capsized Motor Banca (Region VII)

A. Situation Overview:

1. On or about 7:00 PM, 17 October 2015, a capsized motor banca, MB Marsan, occurred between Camotes and Cebu Sea from Isla Kalibutan Bohol bound to Pasil Port Cebu.
2. The motor banca carried 21 passengers and 6 crew.

B. Action/s Taken:

1. All passengers and crew were safely rescued by MV Filipinas Dinagat (Cokaliong Shipping Lines), Light Craft Trans (LCT Golden Bridge) crew, Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) and Central Command (CENTCOM).
2. Rescued passengers are taken cared by CCDRRMC, CSWDO.

2. Initial Report re Fire Incident at Purok 7, Brgy. Poblacion, Valencia City, Bukidnon (Region X)

A. Situation Overview:

1. On or about 11:00 AM, 17 October 2015, a fire incident occurred at Purok 7, Brgy. Poblacion, Valencia City, Bukidnon.
2. The cause of fire and is still under investigation.

C. Action/s Taken:

1. LGU and BFP Valencia City immediately responded to the area and firefight efforts were undertaken.
2. Victims were transported to Valencia City Gymnasium for their temporary shelter.
3. LGU and CSWD Valencia City provided food assistance to the victims at Valencia City Gymnasium.
4. The injured victim was given first aid treatment by the CDRRMC personnel and transported to La viña Hospital, Valencia City.

3. Situation Report No. 1 re Capsized MBCA JEYMARTT (CARAGA)**A. Situation Overview:**

1. On or about 7:00 PM, a motor banca JEYMARTT, owned by Mr. Rizal Tomines, sailing from San Jose, Dinagat Islands to Surigao City, was reported capsized due to great waves at approximately 200 meters away from the coast of Brgy. Zaragosa, Surigao City.
2. The said banca carried 27 passengers, 26 survived while a certain Teofilo Saging, a 41 year old PWD, was an unfortunate casualty.

C. Action/s Taken:

1. PDRRMC – Dinagat Islands deployed Dinagat Islands Search and Rescue (DISAR) to conduct search and rescue.
 2. Francis Al Naluan, member of Dinagat Islands Search and Rescue (DISAR) and one of the passengers, managed for their survival and was initially rescued by the constituents of Brgy. Zaragosa.
 3. Philippine Coast Guard also helped in the rescue.
