Belated Situational Report re Fire Incident in Brgy. Central, San Francisco, Southern Leyte (OCD-VIII)

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 7:30 AM, 17 October 2015, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Central, San Francisco, Southern Leyte, at the residence of Mr. Geronjo Tolibas, married, of legal age, and a farmer.
- 2. At about 7:40 AM of the same date, it was declared fire out.
- 3. Investigation disclosed that the fire started due to the remaining amber in the kitchen.

B. Damages:

- Damage is estimated to be more or less twenty-five thousand pesos (Php25,000).
- 2. There were no reported casualties.

C. Action/s Taken:

- Responding teams were PNP San Francisco and BFP Liloan, both from the Province of Southern Leyte.
- Coordinated with MDRRMO of San Francisco and PSWDO Southern Leyte on the relief assistance that can be extended to the affected household.
