I. Initial Report re Drowning Incident at the Municipality of Siay, Zamboanga Sibugay Province, Region IX

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about **1000H, 20 October 2015**, a drowning incident occurred in a barangay log pond, Municipality of Siay, Zamboanga Sibugay Province. Marian A. Flores, one year and five month old child from the said barangay was left unattended and fell into the log pond near their house. The child was carried away by the strong current caused by heavy rains. The father of the victim requested for help from his neighbours but unfortunately, they were not able to recover the body of the child.
- The barangay officials headed by Barangay Captain Ernesto Dular immediately conducted search and rescue in the area, however, as of this time, the body was not yet found.

B. Effects:

Missing: Marian A. Flores, one year and 5 month old child

C. Actions Taken:

- Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction Management Committee (BDRRMC) conducted search and rescue
- MDRRMO is closely monitoring the situation
- OCDRO IX Operations Center is continuously monitoring the AOR for any disaster related incident

II. Maritime Incident in Guimaras, Region VI

A. Situation Overview

- A passenger motorboat named **MB Tawash** bound for Jordan, Guimaras capsized at around 4:30 PM, Sunday, of October 18, 2015, at about 1.5 nautical miles from the Iloilo wharf, after being battered by strong winds and waves due to Typhoon Lando

- According to the Coast Guard, Iloilo Station and the PDRRMC of the Province of Guimaras, there were **thirty six (36) passengers** and **five (5) crew members**. Of the total number of **forty one (41) on board**; **thirty two (32)** are survivors, **eight (8)** are confirmed dead and **one (1)** is still missing.

C. Actions Taken:

- SAR Team of the PCG in coordination with Brgy. Captain retrieved the dead body who was later identified as Cj Gamutia, 3 to 4 y/o, missing child of capsized M/B "Tawash"
- On or about 09:15 AM, 20 October 2015, the cadaver was brought to the Porras Funeral Parlor, Luna St., Lapaz, Iloilo City
- Ongoing search and rescue operations on the missing person spearheaded by the Philippine Coast Guard
- RDRRMC and PDRRMC-Guimaras coordinated with LDRRMCs concerned for possible citing of the missing person

III. Progress Report re Tornado Incident in Brgys. Sto Niño and Curvada, Tukuran, Zamboanga del Sur

A. Situation Overview:

Enhanced local thunderstorms caused a Tornado Incident in Brgys. Sto Niño and Curvada, both in Tukuran, Zamboanga del Sur on or about **1300H, 18 October 2015**.

B. Effects:

- There were 23 families or 102 persons affected
- An estimated **23 houses (3 partially and 20 totally)** and **3 other**

infrastructures (private establishments and government facilities) were damaged

- **Some power lines were down**
- No casualties reported

C. Actions Taken:

- On the onset of the incident, personnel from the Tukuran Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office, LGU Tukuran, PNP and BFP immediately responded and conducted clearing operations in the affected areas
- Personnel from the ZAMSURECO restored the damaged power lines
- Upon receipt of the report on the incident, OCDRO IX personnel immediately conducted assessment and assisted in the provision of needs to the affected population
- OCDRO IX is continuously monitoring the incident and closely coordinating with the Tukuran MDRRMO for any development and assistance needed

IV. Initial Report re Rido (Family Feud) Incident at Hadji Mohammad Ajul, Basilan

A. Situation Overview:

On **19 October 2015, 05:00 PM**, a Rido (Family Feud) Incident occurred in Brgy Seronggon, Hadji Mohammad Ajul, Basilan

B. Effects:

- The following sustained gunshot wounds:
 - 1) Naim Pawaki, 31 y/o, Male
 - 2) Adih Imih, 16 y/o, Male
- There was no reported IDPs

C. Actions Taken:

- Victims were brought to the Basilan Provincial Hospital in Isabela City for immediate medical treatment
 - OCDRO IX coordinated with Hadji Mohammad Ajul, PDRRMO-Basilan regarding the incident
 - MPS-Hadji Mohammad Ajul is conducting investigation on the said incident
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
