I. Initial Report re: Fire Incident in Jolo, Sulu (ARMM)

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 1440H, 25 October 2015, a fire incident occurred in Brgy Chinese Pier, Jolo, Sulu.

B. Effects:

- A total of 50 houses were totally damaged with estimated total cost of P4,500,000.00
- 886 families / 4,430 individuals were affected and are staying at the Southern Mindanao Islamic Institute while some are with their relatives.

C. Actions Taken:

- BFP-Sulu responded to the incident.
- PDRMMC-Sulu conducted RDANA and initially provided 25 kgs of rice per affected family.
- DSWD-Sulu augmented 886 food packs.
- PRC-Sulu provided hot meals to 290 families.
- OCD-ARMM coordinated with MDRRMC-Jolo and PDRRMC-Sulu regarding the incident.
- OCD-ARMM coordinated with MSWDO-Sumisip on the updates of families affected.

II. Incident Report re: Rally on "Stop Lumad Killings" at UP Diliman, Quezon City (NCR)

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 1900H, 26 October 2015, a crowd of approximately 1,000 members of Gabriela, Anak Pawis, and Bayan Muna converged and walked from Mendiola, Manila to UP Diliman, Quezon City to protest the "Lumad killings". A short program was held from 1900H -1950H of the same date.

The crowd grew to approximately 2,000 people by the time the program ended.

B. Actions Taken:

- OCD-NCR coordinated with QC Police Department and requested for report

III. Initial Report Re: Fire Incident at Brgy. Holy Spirit, Quezon City (NCR)

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 260604H October 2015, a fire incident occurred at No. 7 Vicente St., Commonwealth Ave., Brgy. Holy Spirit, Quezon City involving a residential / commercial establishment. Said fire reached 4th alarm and was declared fire-out at 0635H of the same day
- Cause of fire is still under investigation while estimated cost of damages is yet to be determined

B. Effects:

- Twelve (12) houses and thirty one (31) families were affected
- No casualty was reported
- Estimated damages are still to be determined

C. Actions Taken:

- QC BFP responded to the incident.
- OCD-NCR coordinated with QC BFP and requested for Spot Report
- OCD-NCR coordinated with QC DRRMO for the status of affected families
