1. Lightning Incident in Purok-3, Brgy. Babalaya, Bacolod, Lanao Del Norte (Region X)

A. Situation Overview:

 On or about 1840H 01 November 2015, a lightning incident occurred in Purok-3, Brgy. Babalaya, Bacolod, Lanao Del Norte.

B. Effects:

- Two (2) houses were reportedly partially damaged
- Three (3) persons were injured due to this incident:

C. Actions Taken:

- BDRRMC and Barangay Emergency Response Team (BERT) immediately responded to the incident.
- BDRRMC was advised to take precautionary measures to ensure the safety and welfare of their constituents.

2. Initial Report re Fire Incident in Brgy. 73, PNR Compound, Caloocan City (NCR)

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 1913H 01 November 2015, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 73, PNR Compound, Caloocan City involving residential houses.
- The fire reached 5th alarm and was declared fire out at 2207H, same day.
- The cause of fire, estimated amount of damages, number of affected houses and families are yet to be determined.

B. Effects:

 Two (2) persons sustained minor injuries namely, Jose Romero and F02 Ryan Caincol (BFP)

C. Actions Taken:

- Caloocan BFP and other fire volunteer brigades responded to the incident.
- OCD NCR coordinated with Caloocan City DRRMO re status of the families affected.
