1. Initial Report re Flooding caused by Heavy Rains and Strong Winds in the Province of Misamis Occidental (Region X)

A. Situation Overview:

 On or about 0900H 02 November 2015, flooding of major rivers occured caused by heavy rains and strong winds due to easterlies in Oroquieta City and in the Municipalities of Sinacaban, Jimenez, Aloran, Lopez Jaena

B. Effects:

- One house was partially damaged with an estimated cost of damage amounting to P20,000.00.
- The Sinara Bajo, Mialem and Carmen-Jimenez spillways were impassable for 5 hours.
- · There were no reported casualties.

C. Actions Taken:

- The PDRRMC elevated the alert status to red alert.
- Motorists were temporarily prevented from using the spillway in Sinara Bajo, Mialem, Carmen-Jimenez.
- C/MDRRMCs are now conducting damage assessments.
- Continuous monitoring of the weather situation.

2. Initial Report re Fire Incident in Quezon City (NCR)

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 1322H 03 November 2015 a fire incident occured at #23 Sinagtala St. Brgy. Batasan Hills, Quezon City affecting residential structures.
- The cause of fire is still under investigation

B. Effects:

- Eight (8) families were affected
- Four (4) houses were partially damaged
- The estimated cost of damage amounted to P 60,000,00.
- There were no reported casualties.

C. Actions Taken:

- Affected families were evacuated at Corazon Aquino Elementary School, Barangay Batasan Hills, Quezon City.
- BDRRMC Batasan Hills is providing relief assistance to the affected families.
