1. Rido (Family Feud) Incident in Datu Abdullah Sangki, Maguindanao (ARMM)

A. Situation Overview

- On or about 8:30 PM, 08 November 2015, a rido incident was reported due to land conflict at Sitio Manilong, Barangay Banaba, Datu Abdullah Sangki, Maguindanao

B. Effects

- The incident caused the displacement of 400 families / 2,000 individuals from Barangays Guinibon and Banaba.
- The displaced families/individuals are staying in the Old Municipal Hall in Barangay Banaba and in Barangay Paitan Covered Court in Esperanza, Sultan Kudarat
- Two (2) individuals are reported dead namely: Henry Tabuko, 35 y/o, and a certain Kumander Boboy.

C. Actions Taken

- MDRRMC Datu Abdullah Sangki conducted validation and provided relief assistance to the affected families
- Municipal Police Station (MPS) Datu Abdullah Sangki together with the 33rd IB of the Philippine Army conducted investigation regarding the incident
- OCD ARMM coordinated with MDRRMC Datu Abdullah Sangki and PDRRMC Maguindanao for information regarding the incident

2. Fire Incident in Batangas City (Region IV-A)

A. Situation Overview

- On 10 November 2015, 7:00 AM, a fire incident transpired at Rizal Avenue, Barangay Poblacion 018, Batangas City, Batangas involving a business establishment (eatery)
- The fire was declared under control at 7:20 AM and was declared out at 7:30 AM of the same day

B. Effects

- One (1) individual was declared dead and two (2) persons were injured in the incident:
