I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

"MARILYN" has maintained its strength while moving northward slowly.

Location of Center: (as of 10:00 PM)	985 km East Northeast of Casiguran, Aurora or at 1,015 km East of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan
Coordinates:	17.5°N, 131.3°E
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of 150 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 185 kph .
Movement:	North slowly
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	Tomorrow evening: 1,045 km east of Aparri, Cagayan Wednesday evening: 1,170 km East of Calayan Island, Cagayan Thursday evening: 1,380 km East of Itbayat, Batanes (Outside PAR) Friday evening: 1,885 km East Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (Outside PAR)
NO PUBLIC STORM WARNING SIGNAL	

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the **500 km** diameter of the typhoon.
- Fisher folk are advised not to venture out over the northern and eastern seaboard of Luzon and the northern and eastern seaboard of Samar provinces.
- The public and the disaster risk reduction and management council concerned are advised to take appropriate actions.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- **NDRRMC Operations Center** disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 04 re Typhoon "MARILYN"** to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.

- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants
