I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

"MARILYN" continues to weaken as it exits the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) while moving away from the country

Location of Center: (as of 10:00 AM)	1,430 km East of Itbayat, Batanes (Outside PAR)
Coordinates:	20.0°N, 135.5°E
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of 95 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 120 kph .
Movement:	Forecast to move Northeast at 15 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	Tomorrow morning: 1,740 km east of Itbayat, Batanes (outside PAR) Friday morning: 2,250 km east of Itbayat, Batanes (Outside PAR)

NO PUBLIC STORM WARNING SIGNAL

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the **300 km** diameter of the severe tropical typhoon.
- Fisher folk are advised not to venture out over the northern and eastern seaboard of Luzon.
- **With this development and unless re-entry occurs, this is the final weather bulletin for this weather disturbance.**

II. ACTION/S TAKEN
