1. Belated Report re Vehicular Incident in Busuanga, Palawan (Region IVB)

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 9:00 AM, 5 December 2015, a vehicular incident occurred at Sitio Ocam Ocam, Brgy. New Busuanga, Busuanga, Palawan involving one (1) Izusu Elf Truck with plate number XLG 867, colored blue, driven by Mr. Eric Ramos Espoli, 23 years old, married and caretaker of Ocam Ocam Mission Inn.
- The said vehicle lost control and flipped over while traversing the barangay road going to Brgy. New Busuanga proper.

B. Effects:

- Two (2) individuals were reported dead and other three (3) were injured:

C. Actions Taken:

- OCD MIMAROPA continuously coordinating with MDRRMO and MPS Busuanga, Palawan

2. Initial Report re Fire Incident at Brgy. West Crame, San Juan City (NCR)

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 2:10 AM, 6 December 2015, a fire incident occurred involving a residential area at No. 23, 3rd West Crame Road, Brgy. West Crame, San Juan City.
- The fire reached 4th alarm and was declared fire out at 4:18 AM on the same day
- The cause and origin of fire is still under investigation

B. Effects:

- Approximately 45 houses were partially/totally burned.
- There were approximately 125 families/500 individuals affected and are temporarily evacuated at the Sacred Heart Chapel.
- The estimated cost of damage amounted to Php200,000.00
- A total of seven (7) individuals were injured:

C. Actions Taken:

- San Juan BFP and San Juan DRRMO responded to the incident.
- Standby medic of 2 ambulances along 3rd West Crame Road during the fire incident.
- Standby Medic at the Sacred Heart Chapel along 3rd West Crame Road.
- OCD NCR coordinated with San Juan Fire Station for the Spot Report
- OCD NCR continuously monitoring the incident.

3. Sitrep No. 2 re Vehicular Incident in Salcedo, Eastern Samar

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 12:05 PM, 05 December 2015 a vehicular incident occurred along Maharlika Highway, Sitio Elawod, Brgy. Naparaan, Salcedo, Eastern Samar, involving a Toyota Hi-Ace Van with plate number HVN 942 and with eight (8) people aboard, and a Daewoo Dump Truck with plate number NPI 412, owned by Hanjin Heavy Industry and Construction Company.
- The incident killed six (6) people and injured two (2) others, all from the Toyota Hi-Ace Van. After the incident, the driver of the dump truck fled with his vehicle. The dump truck was later found abandoned by the driver

in Quinapondan, Eastern Samar. Said vehicle was recovered and subsequently brought to Salcedo MPS for documentation and disposition.
